Stock Markets At A Glance

WINNIPEG, Dec. 19 (CP)—United Kingdom buyers took 1,400,000 bushels of Canadian No. 1 and 2 northern wheat today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.

CHICAGO, Dec. 19 (AP)—Grain futures turned weak at the close today under light selling pressure, but there was no sustained interest displayed in any of the pits.

MONTREAL, Dec. 19 (CP)—Security prices on average, easier Monday, were adjusted downward again today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market though some individual promoter spots developed in late trade. Banks alone moved up in the indices. Most of the trading was in papers and utilities.

LONDON, Dec. 19 (CP)—The Stock Market was irregular at the close today after quiet trade. Industrials were mixed and home rails featureless while Oils Kaffirs Diamonds and International securities all tended toward the downside.

TORONTO, Dec. 19 (CP)—Monday's selling gave the gold stocks another downward tilt in today's Toronto Exchange Market and they took an index loss of 87. The Base metal and western oil issues were practically unchanged in the average. Trading was quite active in the final hour to bring the total turnover up to 524,000 shares, a small decline from that of Monday.

NEW YORK, Dec. 9 (AP)—Ralls apparently buoyed by further indications of a lenient European conflict rallied steadily to new 71-year peaks in today's stock market although many industrial leaders were unable to join the excursion. The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up .3 of a point at 58.8. The rails composite jumped a full point to a new top since 1937 for the second time in a week. Transfers totalled 22,322 shares compared with 890,948 the day before.
