

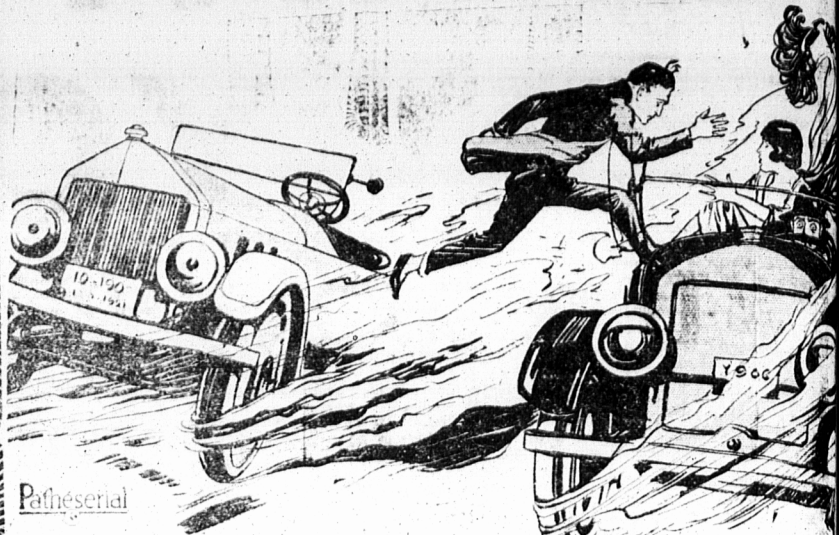

ENVER A PRISONER: HIS GAME OVER.

Enver, who did odd jobs for Abdul Hamid around the Yildiz Kiosk, as a reward for his faithfulness the Sultan promised the carpenter that his son should be educated at the army officer's school. Strange as it seems the Sultan kept his promise and the boy whom he put in the army became the chief actor in his overthrow. Enver was one of the leaders of the Young Turks; he soon became the greatest power in the Ottoman Empire by making himself the head of the Committee of Union and Progress. Through his acquaintance with General Limon von Sanders, the officer sent by the Kaiser to train the Ottoman army, he came easily under German influence. He had Turkey aligned with the Central Empires long before she entered the war. It was undoubtedly his orders that brought about the bombardment of Russian ports and forced Turkey into open hostilities.

Victims of Assassins.

During the World War he was supreme commander of the Ottoman Empire. His two so-called Chief Ministers, Talaat Bey and Djemal Bey, were merely creatures who willingly carried out his orders. Both of these men were made co-defendants with Enver in the Turkish court and both fled from Constantinople at the same time he did. Talaat was killed by an Armenian on the streets of Berlin, and his chief counsel, said Ali Pasha, was killed by an assassin in Italy. Djemal Bey, who has twice escaped assassins, is still a fugitive. One of Enver's friends, Kemal Bey who was convicted with him, was hanged in Constantinople. At that time three other gallowases were standing at the place of execution; the one nearest to Kemal's was pointed out as held specially in reserve for the once powerful war lord himself.
