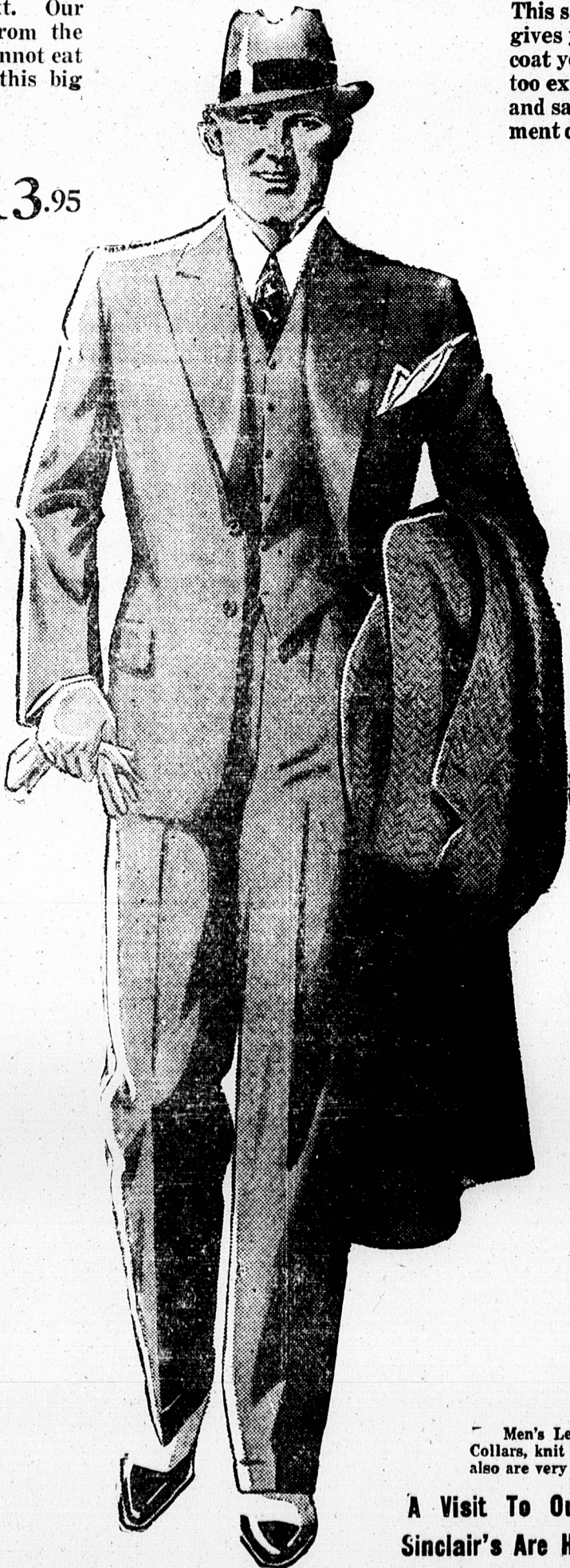

MONTREAL, Dec. 13—A new culture, springing from "the farm woman movement" is coming to the agricultural classes of Canada in

the opinion of Miss Ethel M. Chapman, home section editor of the Farmer Magazine.

As a basis for her statement, made before a meeting of the Montreal Advertising Club, Miss Chapman pointed to present-day farm life, changed, she said, from an existence of monotony to one of interest in daily cultural community activities.

Looking to the future, Miss Chapman said: "It won't be long before the farm people of Canada, as in

Denmark, will be looked upon as the most cultured in the world. The farm women movement had taken a strong hold in Quebec and Ontario especially. Where rural life once meant one dull task after another it was now interspersed with dramatics, musical festival and many youth activities. Miss Chapman predicted introduction of adult education throughout Canada would also have a direct bearing on the future well-being of rural communities.
