THE DUCAL RECEPTION.

[Continued from yesterday issue.]

After the Royal Salute the children added their quota of musical homage. During this the troops were forming for March Past. As the bandy men swung by to the music of the Marine Band cheer after cheer went up from the spectators, the children joining in waving their flags. The scene was simply magnificent. Crew after crew went by, then corps after corps of Royal Marines and Marine Artillery. Ever the enthusiasm grew nor were the plaudits of the onlookers reserved for the regulars. As the local forces swept to the saluting base their friends would start an huzzah that the whole throng cordially seconded.

The Islanders, the holders of cups and prizes innumerable, Ours, the shouts and cheering dwarfed the music of the massed bands and our boys had more enthusiasm than music to march past by as the bands by some one's blundering were put nearly two hundred yards away from their proper position. From the encomiums passed by those on the grand stand our men went by with swinging gait and careful elinement that has always marked their ceremonial work.

The troops after the march past took up their original formation advance in review order, the Royal Salute, was given and the grandest military and naval pageant in maritime annals came to an end. The dense throng was handled beautifully, kept behind the ropes, hundreds of teams, thousands of people and no casualties.

Picture the sight if you can of a score regiments winding off the Common to

every point of the compass, imagine the clash of cymbal and drum, the blare of military band and the shrill piping of the pipers, all these marching off from a given centre; here a driver lashing a lagging gun-horse; there a spirited cavalry charger earcoiling, and ever the steady tramp of the infantry.

Truly it was a display and a pageant well worthy of participation.

The night was spent in seeing the illumination. In vain the clouds poured floods from above; the lights stood out the brighter, nor did the throngs leave the streets till a late hour. Sunday found our contingent at the Garrison Chapel. The hearty singing of the men of the garrison was a delightful feature and would serve as a model to many a Canadian congregation.

The afternoon saw us at the train. For four long hours we remained at Richmond. The train authorities claimed something was amiss with the heating, as if there were no such things as car inspectors! Either that or any old thing was good enough for the militia. We literally froze, those of us who occupied the rear two third lengths of the train and this for a distance of over a hundred miles.

Our discomfort was complete when the restaurant at Truro refused to open its doors.
