THE DOMINION LINER

St. JOHN, March 4.—It has been decided to put the large steamship Dominion on the route between St. John and Liverpool, in place of the wrecked Labrador, and she sails from Liverpool on Thursday next. The

Dominion was built in 1894. She is 6,618 gross and 4,251 net tons, 455 feet long, 55 feet beam and 29 feet 9 inches deep. She is a twin screw boat of 500 horse power. The Dominion is a four-master. She will be one of the largest, if not the largest steamer that has as yet been scheduled for this port.
