SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

JUNE 28

THE SEEKING SAVIOUR

LESSON, Hebrew iv. 14—v. 10

GOLDEN LEXT. Luke xix. 10.

"For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost." As the lessons of the first quarter were mainly concerned with Jesus as the great Teacher, those of the quarter have revealed Him as the great Saviour.

The Golden Text summarizes in the words of the Lord Himself the meaning and the purpose of all His activity. "The Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost." This subject is illustrated from first to last in His own methods with men, but principally in His preparation of His disciples to share in this essential work. Omitting the special lessons for Easter and Whit-Sunday, we have had ten and in reviewing them we discover that most of them show the Lord at this work of preparing His disciples.

Those which most perfectly illustrate Him seeking have been those of His table talk, the rich man and Lazarus, and the young ruler.

In the first of these it is evident that His purpose in rebuking guests and hosts was that of bringing them to a higher level of life, and the parable following thereupon in which He spoke of the great supper was His unveiling of the willingness of God to receive such as are in need, and

His refusal of those who refuse Him. In all this our Lord was seeking these men.

The parable of the rich man and Lazarus was uttered in solemn warning of the Pharisees who were mastered by the love of money by which He sought to compel their attention anew to the relation between the attitudes of this life and the destiny of the life that lies beyond. The whole story of the young ruler is a wonderful illustration of how He seeks men.

The supreme illustration of His saving are those contained in the lesson dealing with Him as the friend of sinners. The picture of the publican justified is that of a man restored to right relationship with God by the way of his own repentance, and the consequent activity of the Divine mercy; while that of Zacchaeus is the picture of a man restored to right relationships with his fellow men as the result of restoration of right relationship with God.

In the other six lessons we have the teaching in which He was preparing His disciples for co-operation in His work. In His words to the multitude by which He sifted them, He revealed His need for helpers, for men to render Him true service.

In the two lessons dealing with the parable of lost things, spoken in answer to the criticism of Pharisees and scribes. He was unveiling the Divine heart, and revealing the Divine activities, in order that men for all time might know His purpose, and as they desired to co-operate with Him, conform thereto.

The lessons dealing with stewardship and the true motive in service, were directed to the same end; while the teaching on the coming of the Kingdom was calculated to fill the hearts of those who would serve Him in the period between the advent with confidence, as they go forth under circumstances of difficulty, to offer the Kingdom of God to men.

RAILS ORDERED BY C. N. RAILWAY.

VANCOUVER, June 18.—The Canadian Northern Railway, has ordered 45,000 tons of steel rails for completion of its lines in British Columbia. Of these 5,000 tons have already left Sydney, C. B., for Port Mann.

SOLD \$60,000,000 CIGARETTES IN QUEBEC LAST YEAR.

MONTREAL, June 18.—Eight hundred million cigarettes were sold in the Province of Quebec during the past year, an increase of two hundred million, or 25 per cent. over the previous year, according to figures presented in a resolution passed by the Methodist Conference last evening. The resolution in question favored a provincial campaign for prohibition of liquor and for checking the growth of the cigarette evil. The conference concluded its annual business after midnight.

INVESTIGATING CHARGES AGAINST POLICE CHIEF

ST. JOHN, June 18.—W. B. Chandler, K. C., city solicitor for Moncton, has been appointed by the Provincial Government, under a Royal Commission, to investigate the charges which have been preferred against W. W. Clark, Chief of Police in this city. It had been rumored that the Government would take this step and the announcement of the appointment has now been made.

The investigation arises from the charges preferred by the Common Council, when submitting to the Government the report of the investigator into the Police Department, which was conducted by the Commissioner of Public Safety. The Government refused to act on the request of the Council for the dismissal of the Chief on the strength of the evidence submitted at this investigation, but promised an investigation of their own if charges were preferred. This step was taken by the Council and the charges, the chief of which was that of inefficiency, were laid before the Government.

As a result of this the Government has appointed Mr. Chandler to conduct an investigation with the intimation that they will be guided by his findings. No announcement has been made, as yet, regarding the date for the opening of the inquiry.

SENTENCED TO DEATH

CALGARY, June 18.—Afanacy Sokoloff, Max Manelick and Joe Smith, three Russians found guilty of murdering Faymaster Wilson, of the Canada Cement Co., at Enshaw, May 22, are sentenced to be hanged at MacLeod on August 26. Mercy is recommended for Manelick. The prisoners robbed Wilson of \$2,300.

NOTED CHINESE BRIGAND ESCAPES AFTER PILLAGE.

PEKING, June 18.—"White Wolf," the notorious Chinese brigand together with 1,900 of his followers, yesterday broke through the circle of regular troops which had surrounded him on Lily Mountain, 100 miles to the South of Lanchow, since June 4. General Chao, with 5,000 regulars, followed the brigands in hot pursuit.

"White Wolf" after devastating the provinces of Hu-Peh, Ho-Nan and Shen-Si, on June 4 attacked Taoh-Chow, in the extreme south of Kan-Su, and after robbing the inhabitants burned the town to the ground. He and his followers were afterwards surrounded by the regular troops.
