OUR SUMMER SCHOOL.

No fewer than 267 teachers have enrolled for the Summer Course now being held at Prince of Wales College, a record attendance which the promoters of similar courses at Halifax and elsewhere are to be excused for envying.

As Premier Mathieson took occasion to point out in his inaugural address, the Summer School, or Course, opens a new era in the educational history of the Island.

This is the first time the teachers of the Province have assembled for the purpose of conducting a summer school, that is for the purpose of making themselves more efficient for the proper discharge of their important duties.

It is to be regretted that the Governor and Mrs. Rogers are out of town at this particular time, for it naturally falls to them, and is part of the social duties of the office, to formally welcome the teachers at a garden party or otherwise.

BYPRODUCTS.

Among the more noteworthy developments of this progressive age is the growth of the idea of conservation. In the days of individual effort when men fought with the natural forces for a bare existence conservation was impossible and waste was universal.

In our own province, during the pioneer days, the hardy settlers had one obstacle to overcome, namely, the forest. This removed, their difficulties would be practically overcome. The kindly virgin soil, barely scratched and given a few seeds, would produce sufficient for the needs of the day.

in the early days been less urgent much of the forest primeval would still be standing.

Perhaps the greatest progress, however, has been made in using the by-products which, in the days of individual effort were absolutely wasted. The item of sawdust alone furnishes an excellent example of this.

And this discovery followed closely upon the establishment of the larger saw-mills where millions of feet of lumber are sawn yearly and where therefore, the saw-dust is in sufficient quantity to be manufactured.

A firm in Vancouver is manufacturing saw-dust into fuel briquets, the saw-dust being compressed into a cylindrical tube where it is cut into short lengths by a revolving knife.

The main thing to be noted, however, is not the uses to which sawdust has been put but the fact that so much valuable material, heretofore wasted, can be utilized at all.

We condemn, in unmeasured terms, the combines, the trusts, the mergers, &c., and yet it is only on the large scale that these enormous wastes can be prevented.
