

EUROPEAN NEWS

MELBOURNE, Nov. 2 (Special)—The problems of problems in Australia at the present time is the cost of living. It rises daily in the rents and the prices of necessities of life, and governments, both State and Federal, are being pressed by all classes to "do something" to stay the process. The price of meat, owing to the operation of local rings and combines, the effects of the drought early in the year, with its destruction of about 10,000,000 sheep, and the advance in labor costs, is the most troublesome circumstance of the many that make up the whole problem.

The Australian consumer has been aroused to a state of indignation by the publication of figures showing that mutton, beef and butter from his own country are often cheaper in London than in Melbourne and Sydney. The Labor Minister of Customs quoted in Parliament last week statistics demonstrating that the wholesale rates in London in April, June, July and August for butter were \$4.25 to \$6.50 per cwt., cheaper than those rates in Melbourne, notwithstanding cost of freight and middlemen's charges!

The figures are disputed by the local trade on the ground that the wrong period of the year was chosen for comparison, and other statistics are put forward to prove that during the last export season consumers in Australia could purchase butter at prices much below the values actually obtained in London. These discussions, however, do not convince the housewife, who knows that she is being led extensively by retailers and "multiple-shop" men.

PARIS, Nov. 2 (Special)—The "Gil Blas" relates that a sister of the French aviator, Tabuteau is one of the sufferers of the Balkan troubles. She had married a Turkish official of Serbian origin, and accompanied him last summer to Berane, a strategic point near the Montenegrin frontier, where he was sent to restore order. She remained at Berane while he went through the province carrying out his instructions.

One day he sent his wife a letter advising her to flee to the mountain fastnesses with her two years old daughter. While she was in refuge in a shepherd's hut her house was pillaged by the local razi, and she endured untold privations until she was able to send a message about her condition to the Montenegrin outposts.

The General sent her a house and enabled her to cross the frontier to the village of Andrijevica. There she learned that her husband had been murdered on the northern confines of the Sanjak while making an official round.

GENEVA, Nov. 2—(Special) A young woman visitor, whose nationality is not stated, who has been staying at a hotel at Davos, was attacked and robbed of about \$20 in her purse on the summit of the Strela Pass, 7,800 feet high above Davos the other afternoon.

The police, accompanied by dogs, which followed the scent, discovered the bandit a few hours later hiding in the woods with a dog he had stolen, and in possession of the stolen money.

The gendarmes, who had a long climb, brought down their prisoner to Davos, where he will be tried.

GENEVA, Nov. 2 (Special)—A Swiss gendarme, Gettried Fischer, who has "worn" a bullet in his heart for the last thirty years, has just died at Zolingen, in the Canton of Argovie, at his home, at the age of sixty-three of a cold on the lungs.

At the age of thirty-three, while pursuing a criminal, he received a bullet in the heart during the chase, and was taken to the hospital in a serious condition.

The doctors did not expect him to recover, but Fischer, to their astonishment, gradually became well and healthy to such a degree that he was able to rejoin the police corps and carry out his ordinary duties for the next 25 years, still carrying the bullet in his heart, as no surgeon would undertake the dangerous operation of removing it, which Fischer declined to undergo without a guarantee.

During the last few days, however, the gendarme began losing weight and health, and this week he passed away unconscious, without pain, and still "wearing" the bullet in his heart.
