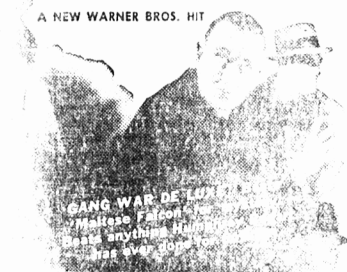

WASHINGTON, Oct. 8—(AP)—The growing destructive power of United States air forces in Egypt was credited officially today with sinking or badly damaging 37 Axis warships and other vessels.

Gen. Russell L. Maxwell advised the War Department that damage from near misses of American bombs and other unobserved destruction probably raised this total of the havoc wrought on the enemy.

In a report summarized by Under-Secretary Robert P. Patterson, the American army commander in the Middle East said the airmen had looted 3,161,000 pounds—about 1,680 tons—of bombs in the past 110 days.
