MYSTERY DEEPENS.

LONDON, Dec. 6.—There was a remarkable development yesterday in the investigation into the robbery of \$50,000 worth of sovereigns contained in two cases of a consignment of one million shipped by the Bank of England to the Credit Lyonnais at Alexandria, Egypt, about three weeks ago.

The continental police believe that they were certainly intercepted by the same gang which planned and carried out the original robbery. The police were anxious here to ascertain whether the original robbery was effected by a substitute of cases or by the abstraction of the gold and the resealing of the cases with carefully imitated seals of the Bank of England and the Credit Lyonnais.

NO TRACE OF MORIEN.

LOUISBURG, Dec. 6.—The steamer Lady Laurier arrived back from her fruitless search for the long overdue steamer Morien this afternoon. The Lady Laurier left port on Sunday last and steamed westward to Sable Island but saw no trace of the steamer reported by the Mexican.

SYDNEY, Dec. 5.—The steamer City of Sydney returned last evening with no news of the steamer Morien. She may be held here a few days for the Dominion Wreck Commissioner's investigation, into the causes which led to the collision between that steamer and the tug D. E. Thomas in the harbor on the night of November 13, which resulted in the drowning of five men.

the Dominion Coal Co. this morning the Chronicle was informed the date of investigation has not been definitely decided. It is thought probably that the Captain and several members of the crew of the Sydney will remain here, and the boat allowed to proceed to St. John's, Nfld., to discharge cargo.

OPPOSES CHURCH UNION.

QUEBEC, Dec. 6.—The Bishop of Quebec has issued a pastoral letter to all the clergy of his diocese strongly condemning the circular letter with the proposals for church unity which has been drawn up by certain clergymen of the Anglican church in Canada.

The letter is signed not only by the bishop, but by the whole cathedral council, consisting of the dean, archdeacon and the canons of Quebec.
