

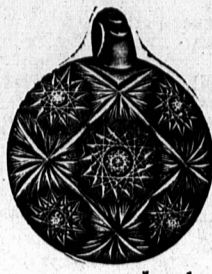

Next week the Marathon Road race will be run in this City. A fine course has been mapped out and the start and finish of the race will be near the Patriot office, thus affording citizens a good opportunity of seeing the contestants. A large number of entries are in and there is bound to be an interesting race.

An abundant catch of lobsters is reported from all points along the Northumberland Strait, says the Amherst News, and the packers are wearing a broad smile in consequence, as foreign prices are high and likely to be maintained in the future. In perau and shad are also reported in large quantities, and promises to be a rich and profitable one.

Beginning with tomorrow morning at the Central Christian Church, in this City, a series of revival services will be conducted by Clarence D. The annual meeting of the Maritime Stock Breeders Association and Winter Fair was held at Amherst Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. J. B. Spencer of Ottawa acting stock commissioner was in attendance. The business organization was thoroughly gone into and a statement of finances showed a deficit of about \$1500 to date. This is met by a \$200 grant from Nova Scotia government, and a \$1,300 grant from the federal department. Grants of \$2,400 from the federal department, \$1,200 from Nova Scotia, \$800 from New Brunswick and \$400 from P. E. Island and other sources of revenue will make the association self-sustaining in future. MEETING OF PRESBYTERY Supplies Etc.- Induction Of Rev. John Hawley At Marshfield.

At Marshfield on Monday, June 1st, 1908, and within the Presbyterian Church there at the hour of seven o'clock p. m., the Presbytery of P. E. Island met pursuant to adjournment and was constituted in the prayer by the moderator, Mr. J. W. McKenzie with whom were present Messrs Ross, Green, McPhail, Hawley, Smith, ministers, and Mr. L. H.
