...The annual meeting of the New
Perth Dairymen's Association was held in
the New Perth hall recently. The fol-

...Souris east has a new circular
iron lantern on the lighthouse on
Knight Point, east coast of P. E. I.
The character of the light will be
changed from a fixed white light to
a flashing white light, showing two
flashes of 23 seconds duration each,
separated by an eclipse of 78 second,
and followed by an eclipse of 3.78
seconds' duration, the total period
being five seconds. The light will be
mounted 36 feet above high water
mark, and should be visible 15 miles
from all points seaward. The illumina-
ting apparatus is dioptric of the
fourth order; and the illuminant pet-
roleum vapour, burned under an in-
candescent mantle. The height of the
lighthouse from its base to the vane
on the lantern is 47 feet.

...Frank McDonald a son of the late
Capt. John McDonald, of George-
town Cottage Farm, graduated from
college fifteen years ago, and went to
Rumford Falls, where he held a posi-
tion, as superintendent of the chemi-
cal mills. After a few years he in-
vented a chemical plant, known as
the Macdonald Electrical System,
which he put in operation in several
parts of the world. Four years ago
he put in a plant at Denver, Colora-
do. During his stay, he invented a
method to separate the gold from
the ore, which is driven by electri-
city—the first invention of that kind
known in the world got it patented
and sold it for a large sum of
money. Mr. Macdonald has an office at
41 Bank Row, New York, and owns a
residence in Johnsburg, Pa. He
has two brothers and one sister, Mrs.
James Wood, Lake Verd.
