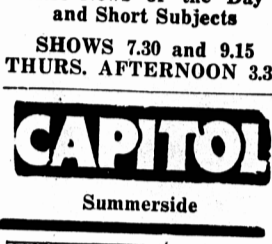

Places Onus Of Car Ferry Delay On Government

Following is a continuation of the report of the speech of Hon. Dr. W. J. P. MacMillan, leader of the Opposition, in the Draft Address debate in the Legislature on Tuesday:

Car Ferry Problem The speech from the Throne dealt with the importance of agricultural production, but it neglected to say anything about the problem of the transportation of agricultural products.

Dr. MacMillan: "Your Government because if you had done your full duty you would have gone to Ottawa and stayed there until you made those people - especially the responsible minister, Mr. Howe - give us some consideration."

Premier Campbell: "This is in order, to charge Mr. Howe with a misstatement?"

Dr. MacMillan: "Yes; he gave out two contradictory statements, neither of them correct, regarding the sinking of the 'Charlottetown'."
