SACRED SPOT RESTORED

LONDON, Dec. 23.—(British United Press)—"You must go over to Capernaum and see the synagogue they are reconstructing there; the one in which Christ preached!"

That is the greeting visitors receive from Father Tapper, at the hospice of Talgha, on the northern shores of the Sea of Galilee. Tiberias is the only city on the lake today, and under Jewish activity is growing rapidly.

It boasts of its power station, electric light, factories, hotels, motor garages, telephone service, and such like blessings of modern civilization—and within a mile of it is the authentic spot where Christ performed the miracle of feeding five thousand.

The site of the synagogue was discovered in 1886 but doubt existed until it passed into the hands of the Franciscans, and a thorough examination of the ruins was then made.

Broken columns, bases, friezes, and massive white stones are all that remain today of what was once the city of Capernaum. On his first visit there Christ performed two miracles—the healing of Peter's wife's mother, who was sick with a fever, and the curing of the demoniac in the synagogue.

Excavation of the site has proceeded at a great pace. Capernaum, it is thought, must have been destroyed by an earthquake, and this view is supported by the fact that none of the stones of which the synagogue was built is missing.

The lower portions of the main walls are still intact, rising to a height of about five feet. They were fashioned from great blocks of stone, resembling white marble. Three staircases by which the building was entered are also intact, as well as the bases of most of the columns. It was evidently built in the Graeco-Roman style, dating from the first century. It covered an area of about 80 feet by 40 feet, with a nave, aisles, and women's gallery, as well as a court with a fountain for ablutions.

The cornices and friezes were elaborately embellished with all kinds of Jewish emblems, including grapes and pomegranates, the five-pointed star the seven-branched candlestick, and a curious structure of wheels, believed to represent the Ark of the Covenant.
