REMOVING GUNS.—The guns at Table Head Sydney Mines, and Low Point, C. B., where many island boys served on garrison duty during the war, are being removed to Halifax. Four officers and about thirty men arrived in town last week to assist the Glace Bay Gazette, to assist in the removal of the guns and ammunition. A motor lorry also arrived from Halifax to assist in the removal of the ammunition. It will take nine box cars to transport the guns and ammunition to Sydney where they will be taken to Halifax. The gun at Table Head is a six-inch one. There are two guns at Low Point one six-inch and one eight-inch. The guns are being dismantled today. It will be several days yet before the removal is completed.
