WINNIPEG, Jan. 26 (CP)—Weakness at Chicago near the close of the session brought out a little late selling on Winnipeg wheat futures market today, causing prices to slip from gains scored in early trading. Final quotations were 1-8 cent higher to 1-8 cent lower with May at 63 1/4, July 64 and October 64 1-4 cents.

Liverpool showed a firm tone when the demand for Australian wheat continued and English values closed 1-2 1/2-3-8d higher.

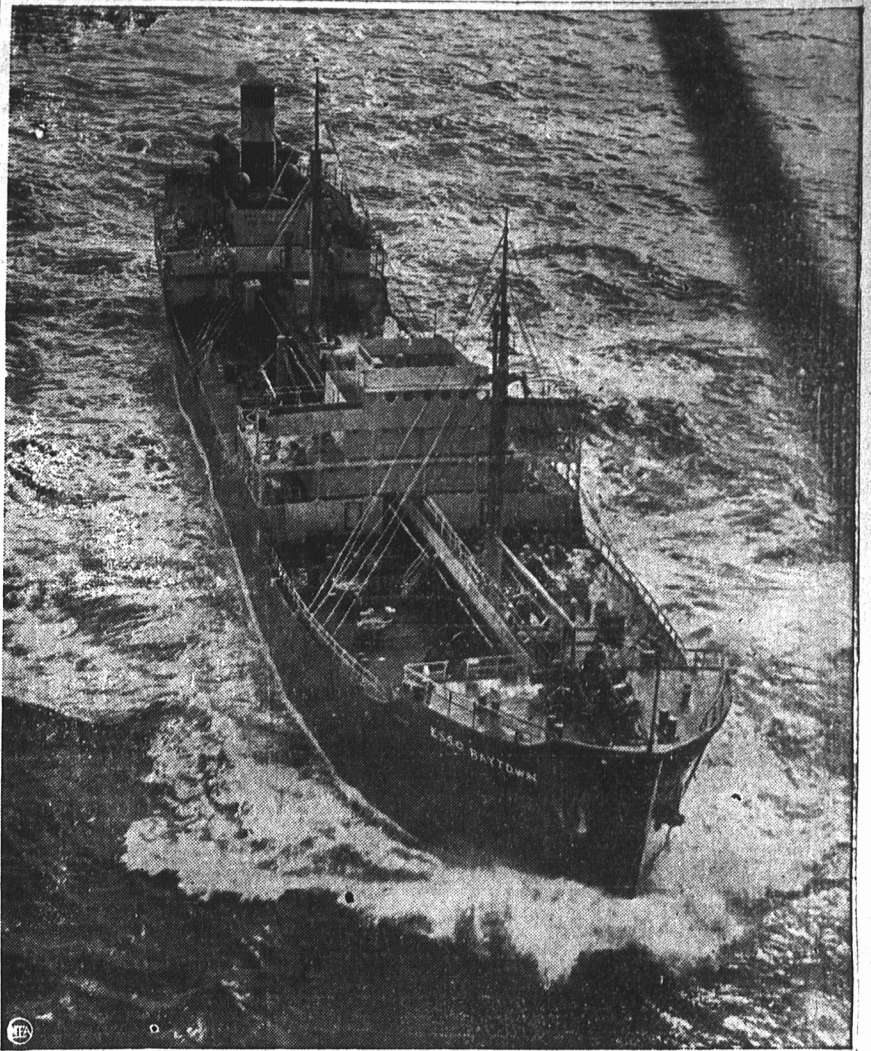

## RESCUE SHIP BATTLING STORMS FAR AT SEA



With his fragile plane yawing crazily under the lash of an icy gale, Joseph Boyle, NEA Service's flying cameraman, located the homing rescue ship Esso Baytown 70 miles east of Sea Girt, N. J. He took this exclusive picture of the tanker fighting through angry boiling seas toward New York with the survivors of the sunken British flying boat Cavalier. On a previous unsuccessful quest for the Esso Baytown, Boyle flew 100 miles over the storm-ridden Atlantic and back.



Above is Capt. Alderson who was heroically rescued from the Bermuda Airliner Cavalier, suffering from exposure and shock. Robert Spence, Steward and J. Gordon Noakes of Malba, L.I. a passenger on the ill-fated liner are among the missing.

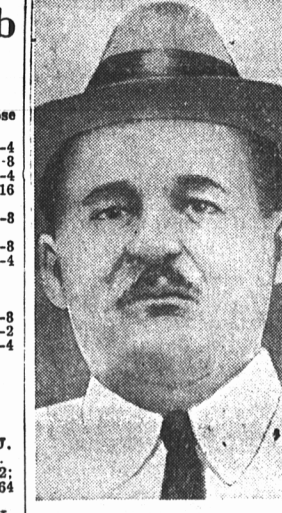
