TORONTO GLOBE ON MAR. UNION

TORONTO, Oct. 9.—The Globe tomorrow morning will say editorially:—

"Despatches from the provinces down by the sea indicate that a movement for union into one province is largely in the hands of dissatisfied members of both political parties. It is said that there is a movement on foot to found a third party, having a union of the three provinces as its chief and only policy. Just why a third party should be necessary to carry out this or any other desirable reform does not at this distance appear. If there are evils in provincial politics in eastern Canada, they need not be regarded as likely to yield to any change of system. Faith in the efficacy of such changes as a means of political regeneration weakens with experience. But such faith may lead to the formation of a third party to promote maritime union."

"It may be that there is opposition from the established provincial legislatures. A man who is comfortably elected is apt to conclude that the existing system allows little or no room for improvements. The proposed union would lessen the number of representatives and the men likely to be cut off cannot be expected to manifest much enthusiasm in favor of a change."

"In fact, the lessening of the representation and cutting away of machinery of government are the chief benefits to be derived from the proposed union, and those whose positions would be abolished or whose seats would be dispensed with must be expected to form a solid opposition. This may account for the attempt to concentrate the unionist effort in a third party. A legislature is, in a measure, a commercial interest on which many place total dependence, and this strengthens the forces opposed to abolition."

Opinions will differ as to the best method of promoting a change and of effecting the desired economies in the eastern local government, but that a change is desirable cannot be denied. It is an affair for our eastern fellow citizens to work out in their own way, and the other provinces will regard their efforts with sympathetic interest.

HUSBAND PLAYS A FATAL JOKE

Hinton, W. V. A., Oct. 9.—As the result of a joke on his wife, Charles Smith, mayor of the little town of Brooklyn, near here, is believed to be dying, and Mrs. Smith is also probably fatally wounded. Smith had Elbert Medley dress up as a woman and called him out to the gate. Mrs. Smith, maddened by jealousy shot her husband through the stomach and lung, then shot herself.

THE DREADNAUGHT PROVES A FLYER

SPRINGFIELD, Oct. 8.—The battleship Dreadnaught anchored here this evening after a full steam trial of 172 eight hours, in which she reached a speed of 22 knots, the mean average being 21. Her horsepower, which is nominally 23,000, went as high as 28,000. These results were achieved in the face of increased load resulting from preparations for a sea-going trip, which added to feet to her draught. Complete absence of vibration was again recorded.
