EARLY STEAM COMMUNICATION TO THE MAINLAND

In the Colonial Herald of Sept. 10th. 1840 is an account of a meeting to secure a steamer for communication between Charlottetown and Pictou and if practicable to include Miramichi.

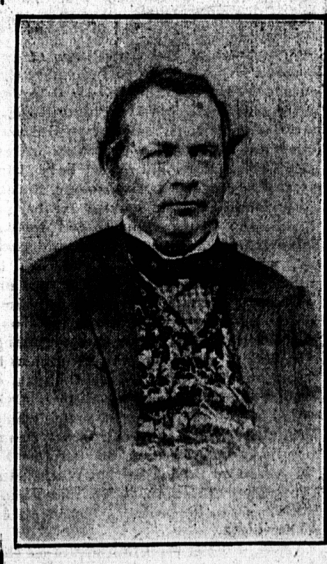

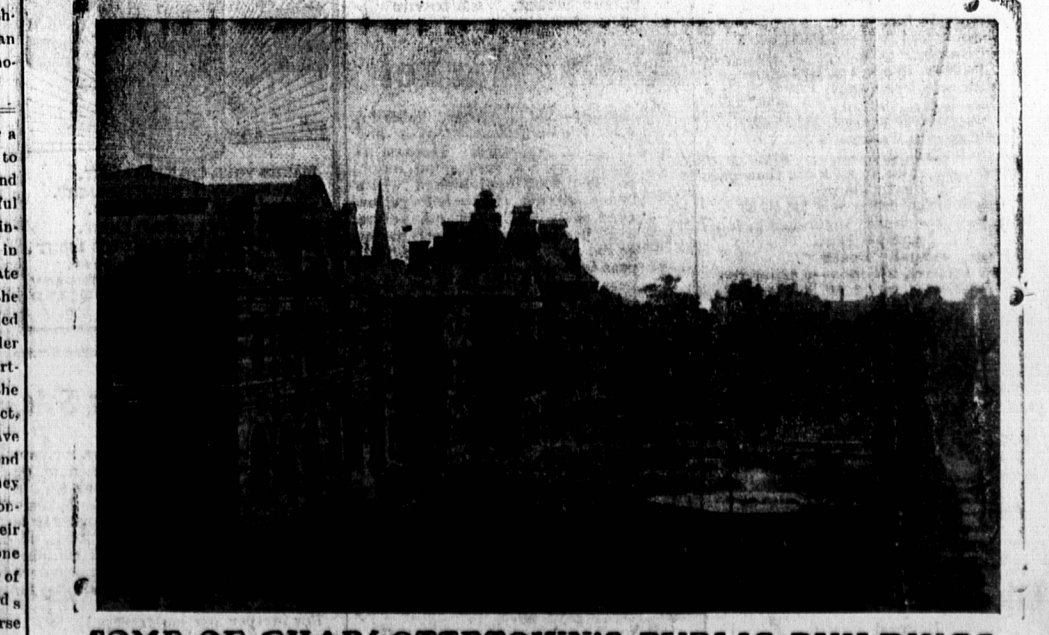
