Ponder Use Of World's Largest Shipping Fleet

(By Clyde Blackburn, Canadian Press Staff Writer) WASHINGTON, Sept. 9 — The About two-thirds of all the world's merchant shipping belongs to the United States and the problem of using it to the best advantage of Americans and the world in general is one of the first-class problems of the moment—one that may eventually reach the United Nations.

The whole story has been told in a 128-page pamphlet—"The Post-War Outlook for American Shipping"—now being circulated. The report was prepared for the United States Maritime Commission by the post-war planning committee set up three years ago.

It suggests the many proposals for international co-operation toward peace, economic equilibrium and reciprocity in trade cannot succeed unless there is collaboration on division of the world's shipping business.

Canada, the report notes, "has several times as much tonnage as the United States." It is possible that is raised that the Dominion and other British Commonwealth countries will "assist in developing large fleets of their own."

The same was true of other countries which have proved in the past their ability to compete successfully for ocean commerce. On June 30, 1939 the United States had a total of 1,338 merchant vessels aggregating 8,135,600 gross tons. Of those 306 aggregating 1,736,000 tons were inactive on Sept. 1, 1945, the United States had 5,529 ocean-going merchant vessels aggregating 40,000,000 gross tons. At that time the ocean-going merchant tonnage of the world was 10,176 vessels aggregating 65,959,000 gross tons.

The pre-war merchant fleet was financially unsatisfactory, the fleet was shrinking and 90 per cent of the vessels were "either obsolete or approaching obsolescence."

Now the planning is for American ships to get a larger share of the business but to avoid a large scale contest for ocean going business; to maintain a constantly up-to-date merchant fleet both for business reasons and for use in the event of war.
