LANIER and Martin. La Poudre aux Yeux. A comedy in two acts. Edited by Victor E. Francis, A. M., Instructor in French, College of the City of New York. Cloth, 12mo, 111 pages, with introduction, notes, exercises, and vocabulary. Price, 30 cents. Verne. Les Enfants du Capitaine Grant. Edited by Edith Healy. Cloth, 12mo, 127 pages, with notes and vocabulary. Price, 30 cents. American Book Company, New York, Cincinnati, and Chicago. These two books have been received. La Poudre aux Yeux is one of Lanier's most famous plays. Besides an introduction, notes, and vocabulary, this edition furnishes valuable composition drill in the form of exercises based on specific portions of the text. Jules Verne's books have given constant delight and they are suitable for students in this country who are beginning to read French. Les Enfants du Capitaine Grant affords a thrilling account of the adventures of two children in search of their shipwrecked father. Notes and a vocabulary complete the book.

The Republicans of Boston who eliminated Senator Frederick J. MacLeod from the political map, in redistricting the senatorial districts, have raised a storm in a quarter they little dreamed of, for Senator MacLeod is not only a firm believer in reciprocity with Canada, but is himself a Canadian by birth. Former Alderman Asa. R. Minard of Medford, secretary of the Canadian Club and a Republican of prominence, has denounced what he termed the act of the stand-pat Republican machine in destroying the MacLeod senatorial district because it had been carried by a Democrat, and declared that if the Legislature passed the bill as drawn, it would cost the Republican party thousands of votes in the State. "I have read with surprise of this assault upon the MacLeod district," said Secretary Minard yesterday. "It seems to me wholly unwarrantable. I have voted the Republican ticket consistently for the past 12 years, but I am forced to admit that such a proceeding as this is almost enough to make one cool. I suppose Senator MacLeod is as pronounced a liberal tariff man as there is in the Legislature. Whether Democrat or Republican, he has served the State creditably during his year of service. If this scheme goes through it would not surprise me to see a lot of trouble for the Republicans all over the State, for Canadian voters will naturally feel that a direct affront has been offered them. 'The reciprocity people are not asleep, and they are growing stronger.' The cutting off of Ward 3, Cambridge, from the MacLeod senatorial district was the cause of trouble. With Ward 3 it was Democratic by one vote, on the basis of the vote of last year. The redistricting fight promises to be interesting all along the line during the week. The new Boston districts in particular have been causing some lively discussions among the politicians. The Senator MacLeod above referred to is Fred. J. MacLeod, well known here and a son of the late Hector MacLeod of St. Peters Road. He is one of Harvard's most brilliant graduates and practices law in Boston.
