Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, Sept. 20 — (AP) — Wheat futures lost almost a cent a bushel in early trade today and steadied near the close. Rye also advanced slightly after losing more than a cent.
WINNIPEG, Sept. 20 — (CP) — Rye futures prices on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange moved irregularly today showing an easier tone in the first half of the session. Later, offerings dried up and buying came into the market from local interests and shippers. Trading was moderately active.
NEW YORK, Sept. 20 — (AP) — Further strength of rails and selected industrials lifted the Stock Market averages to another eight-year peak today although many leaders displayed considerable rising antipathy.
Transfers totalled 1,500,000 shares compared with 1,690,000 the day before.
The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up 4 of a point at 70.3, highest mark since April 22, 1937.
TORONTO, Sept. 20 — (CP) — The Toronto Stock Exchange today recorded its most active trade since spring with 2,468,000 shares traded at the close of a session featured by specialty trading in the junior goods. Index gains were recorded for all groups.

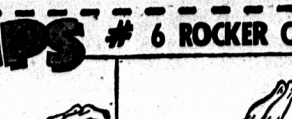

SPORT-TIPS # 6 ROCKER CURL by Ace Poirer



Part 1 The "Rocker Curl" will develop a strong, supple back. Lie flat on floor. Raise upper body far as possible with arms wide apart. Return to position.



Part 2 Next raise lower body and legs high as possible. Keep legs straight, knees locked together. Alternate upper and lower body lifts until tired.



Part 3 From same position as before raise both upper and lower body at the same time. Keep legs straight and lift hard. Repeat until tired.

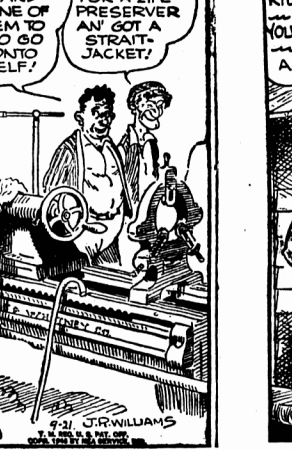
