BITS OF JAPANESE POETRY.

One of the readers of yesterday's Guardian asks for some bits of Japanese poetry to supplement the proverbs already given.

Chocho ni... Kyoneu shishitaru Tauma koishi!

Which being translated gives only this:—"Two butterflies! Last year my dear wife died!" But it may be explained that to the Japanese the butterfly is a symbol of happy marriage.

And here is another a little longer, expressive of a Memory in Spring: She, who departing hence, left to the flowers of the plum tree Blooming beside our eaves the charm of her youth and beauty.

And this, in a Cemetery at night: The light of the moon that plays on the water I pour for the dead,

Differs nothing at all from the moonlight of other years.

Here is the poet's expression of the Sublimity of Intellectual Power: The mind that, undimmed, absorbs the foul and the pure together—

Call it rather a sea, one thousand fathoms deep! This poem of three lines, is intended to convey the idea of Loneliness:

Old temple; Bell voiceless; Cherry-flowers fall. Three pretty lines of longer measure tell of Return After Long Absence: The garden that once I loved, and even the hedge of the garden.—

All is changed and strange; the moon-light only is faithful; The moon alone remembers the charm of the time gone by!

These few bits must suffice for the time. They may serve to show that Japanese thought and fancy are not after all, so very unlike our own.
