Stock Markets Quiet, Prices Easier Yesterday

NEW YORK, March 28 (AP)—The stock market stirred in its sleep today but never woke up. Small, early gains were shaved off in later trading. Steels today were virtually unchanged. Railroads asked for additional revenue for carrying U. S. mail in 1947. They need the money, they told the Interstate Commerce Commission in a petition, to meet higher wages and other operating costs. The market as a whole today did virtually nothing. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was unchanged at 63.3. The industrial component was unchanged, rails lost .1 of a point and utilities advanced .1 of a point. The volume of 700,000 shares was about average.
