JESUS APPEARS TO JOHN. Rev. I. 9-20. Memory verses, 17, 18.

GOLDEN TEXT.

Jesus Christ, the same yesterday and to-day, and for ever.—Heb. 13, 8.

OUTLINE.

1. The Messages to the Churches, v. 6-11  
2. The Glorified Redeemer, v. 17-20  
LESSON HELPS.

9. "I John"—He was one of the apostles, and known as the disciple whom Jesus loved. He was affectionate, and his life and his writings have been a blessing to the church. "Your brother"—That was addressed to the seven churches of Asia, which were suffering from persecution, and hence John was their companion in tribulation, and what he wrote was for their comfort and his own. "The isle that is called Patmos."—Where John was banished, under the Roman emperor Domitian. Though an exile, he had the vision of heaven and the angels to cheer him.

10. "In the spirit"—In a state of ecstasy in which the unseen world became more real than the world about him. "On the Lord's day"—The first use of this phrase. The first day of the week the day made memorable by the resurrection of our Lord, was celebrated by the early church as a day of worship. "A great voice"—Which like a trumpet summoned attention. The trumpet was used to call attention to the religious feasts.

11. "Alpha and Omega"—The first and last letters of the Greek alphabet, and is explained by the phrase "the first and the last," Write in a book"—And it now forms a part of the Bible, which is the Book of books.

12. "See the voice"—To see whence the voice and who had spoken. "Seven golden candlesticks"—Or lampstands. Seven was in Jewish thought a sacred number and they were golden, that is, very precious. These seven lamps differed from the one lamp with seven branches in the Jewish temple, but, like that, these lamps, the seven churches, were to shed the light of truth. Churches are to be light-bearers to the glory of God.

13, 14. "In the midst"—This shows the continual presence of Christ with his church. "Like unto the cross he now sees in a glorified state. "A garment down to the foot . . . a golden girdle"—These show high rank, and are emblems of the eternal priesthood. "White like wool"—That is, white as white wool, and the colour signifies purity and glory. Eyes were as a flame of fire"—That is, bright searching, and, to his foes congluming.

15, 16. "Fine Brass"—That is brass which has been heated to a white heat in the furnace and is now polished. At the sound of many waters"—This sound throws how might and grand, and also how terrible he was whose voice was like this. "Seven stars"—As one might hold in his hand a crown The sword which came from the mouth is an emblem of the triumph of the truth spoken over the falsehoods of the world. "As the sun shineth" is a poetic and forceful image of the unclouded splendour of the Son of Man whose throne is in heaven.

17, 18. "Fell at his feet"—For weak human nature was overcome by the vision of such a one from the heavenly world. "His right hand upon me"—It was placed upon him not in wrath but in mercy, and there came the assuring command, "Fear not." When God assures us safe.

18. "Liveth, and was dead"—Christ liveth from eternity upon the throne; he died upon the cross, and now he is alive for evermore. "Keys of hell and death."—Keys are emblems of authority, and the world held here has the force of the Greek word Hades, which is the plate of disembodied spirits. Jesus has power to release from the grave.

19, 20. "Write"—And the power of a writer of revealed truth about God and with the growing ages. "Mystery"—The hidden truth veiled under the figure of the stars and the candlesticks, and move no longer a mystery but a revelation. "The angels of the seven churches" means here the chief pastors of those churches.

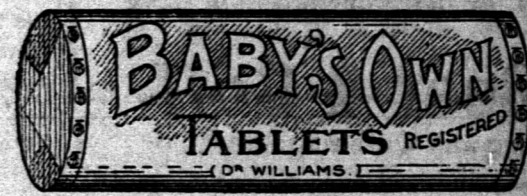

## All Coming To It.

Toronto Globe: No company or organization can be as well qualified as the post office department to give the Dominion a cheap and efficient telegraph service. The question of establishing the telephone service under the same management must soon come up for consideration and the Ottawa board of trade may have the honor of inaugurating a complete revolution of our systems of electric communication.

Montreal Witness: Sooner or later the Canadian government will take over the control and management of the telegraph business of the country. The telegraph, including the telephone, is obviously merely a branch of the system of public communication of which the post-office has hitherto been, and will for some time to come be, the main trunk. The post, once in private hands, is now

managed by governments in all auxiliary systems which have been established later will inevitably follow the earlier system by passing under government control. This was foreseen when the Dominion telegraph act was passed as it provides carefully for the transfer of all systems established under it to the government when that course is determined upon by parliament. Reasonably or unreasonably, Canadians, when called upon to consider the question seriously, will come to the conclusion that somehow or other their country has in this matter lagged behind the rest of the empire, and will undoubtedly decide that the government should, as soon as convenient, take over the control of this public service.
