CONSERVATIVES GAIN IN QUEENS.

HALIFAX, Feb. 17—The local bye-election in Queens yesterday, to fill the vacancy caused by the appointment of Hon. Mr. Farrell to the Senate, resulted in the election of Mr. Hall, a Conservative, over Henry, a Liberal, by 223 majority. The Temperance Alliance joined forces with the Conservatives, and headed by a quartette of clergymen, conducted a vigorous fight which resulted in a Conservative victory.

PORK ADVANCING.

CHICAGO, Feb. 16—The widespread movement against the high price of meat has failed to check the advance in prices of hogs. Live hogs at the stock yards here sold today at the highest mark, with one exception, in the last forty years. The new high point recorded today was \$9.27 1/2 per hundred pounds and predictions were made that in a few weeks the \$10-level will have been passed. Simultaneously the price of hog products also made marked advances. Pork for May delivery sold today at \$23.65 per lb. This is the highest price since the civil war, except in 1887.

SCHOONER OVERTURNED WITH CREW OF SIX.

GLOUCESTER, Feb. 17—Although the quarter-board containing the name of a two-masted schooner which floated bottom up, off Eastern Point was picked up by the revenue cutter "Androscooguit" is hidden in the weeds in which the schooner grounded, it is almost certain that the ill-fated craft is the old-time coaster, "Prescott," of Rockland, which left Portland lumber-laden, Feb. 11th. Her crew of probably half a dozen men have undoubtedly found a watery grave.

PEN SKETCH OF REV. D. HUTCHINSON.

The St. John Times contains the following pen sketch of Rev. David Hutchinson, well known in Charlottetown. "The right man in the right place," is your instinctive thought as you watch Mr Hutchinson facing his large congregation. He enters the pulpit with a brisk, alert, authoritative air. He speaks and acts with deliberateness. He is a born leader of men, and his tones are those of command. He comes as one having authority. He understands the mind of the average man, and to that mind he directs his arguments and appeals with an unerring instinct. His preaching is rather practical than theological; but he stands resolutely by the great evangelical positions, and can expound and defend them in a sound, able and straightforward fashion. While his vocabulary is not specially copious, it is suitable and sufficient, and is hardly ever deficient in force. His gestures are appropriate and effective. His style of oratory is admirably adapted to the somewhat difficult acoustics of the main street church his voice being clear and penetrating and his delivery measured and emphatic. Indeed, if it fails it is on the side of over-emphasis, and in the lack of tenderness. To hear him when at his best is to hear him when he is fighting some great evil, such as intemperance. He strikes right out from the shoulder. Like his original namesake he has a knack of hitting the mark, and starts fall before the well-directed shot.

Mr Hutchinson would have succeeded in almost any calling. Had he been an Episcopalian he would ere long have been a bishop. However, he is one already, and it is our fondest hope that he may long be spared to shepherd his great and growing flock at Main street.
