MR. TARTE IS NOW A PRIVATE MEMBER.

The Minister of Public Works Sends in His Resignation to Sir Wilfrid Laurier on Monday—Constitutional Usage Observed.

OTTAWA, Oct. 21.—Hon. J. I. Tarte is to-day a private member of the House of Commons. Many will be prepared for this announcement. There was no other outcome possible. The premier acted firmly and promptly in the matter. Mr. Tarte sent his resignation from Toronto yesterday and it reached Sir Wilfrid Laurier's hands this forenoon. It was immediately accepted. As soon as this was done the First Minister gave both letters to the press correspondents. As was to be expected Sir Wilfrid took the correct constitutional view of the question, and although refusing to discuss the economic theory of Mr. Tarte as a champion, the Prime Minister does not hesitate to say that it is a question subordinate to a still more important one.

SIR WILFRID'S LETTER. The following letters which passed between the Premier and the Minister of Public Works fully explain the matter. Sir Wilfrid Laurier writes Mr. Tarte to-day as follows:— OTTAWA, Ont., Oct. 21. My Dear Tarte—After having seen you on Sunday and having expressed to you my well settled opinion upon the consequence of your recent attitude, my first duty was to wait upon His Excellency the Governor General, to inform him that I was obliged to demand the resignation of your portfolio. After having seen His Excellency I had to acquaint my colleagues of the interview which I had had with you. In accepting your resignation it is well to emphasize the points of difference between us. During my absence in Europe without any communication with me and without any previous understanding with your colleagues, you began an active campaign in favor of a revision of the tariff in the direction of high protection. I regret having been obliged to observe to you that this attitude on your part constitutes a self evident violation of your duty towards the government of which you were a member. I repeat to you here what I told you on Sunday, I did not wish to discuss at this moment the economic theory of which you have made yourself the champion. This question however important it might be is subordinate to one still more important. If you had reached the conclusion that the interests of the country demanded without delay an increase of the customs duties the first thing for you to do as a member of government, before addressing your views to the public, would have been to place them before your colleagues with the object of obtaining the unanimous action of the Cabinet which is the very foundation of responsible government. Failing to obtain from your colleagues their assent to the course which you recommended, you would have been obliged then either to accept their own views or to sever your connection with them, and then for the first time would you have been free to place your views before the public. Such was the very simple course which was being upon you. But to remain a member of the Government and at the same time advocate a policy which had not yet been adopted by the government, which is an impediment to the working of the constitutional system implies a disregard for that loyalty which all those who are members of the same administration owe to each other and have a right to expect from each other.

I thank you for the good wishes which you express for the improvement of my health and I will make it my duty to convey to your old colleagues those that you formulate for their welfare and their happiness. Believe me, Yours very sincerely, WILFRID LAURIER. The above letter was written in reply to the following one dated from Toronto, yesterday:— Toronto, Oct., Oct. 21st. The Right Hon. Sir Wilfrid Laurier, Prime Minister, Ottawa: My Dear Sir Wilfrid:—

I feel it my duty to place my resignation in your hands, and to ask you to be good enough to have it accepted by His Excellency the Governor-General. In the interview which I had with you, you expressed the opinion that I should not have spoken on the tariff as I have done, that the government had not as yet come to any definite understanding on their fiscal policy for the future, etc. I shall not discuss with you at the present time, the question as to whether I was right or wrong in the course I followed. You are the leader of the government and your opinion, as far as my attitude is involved, must prevail. You told me my utterances are causing you trouble. I have no right to cause any embarrassment to you or to the party with which I have been connected since 1892. My views on the tariff are well known to you. I have on several occasions stated them publicly in your presence, and discussed them often privately with you. Entertaining the opinion that the interests of the people make it our duty to revise without delay the tariff of 1897, with the view of giving a more adequate protection to our industries, to our farming community, to our workmen, I cannot possibly remain silent. I prefer my freedom of action and of speech, under the circumstances even to the great honour of being your colleague. Before severing my official relations with you allow me to express my sincerest hope that you will soon be restored to your health of former days. You will greatly oblige me by conveying to my colleagues my best wishes for their welfare and their happiness. My personal relations with most of them have been of a pleasant and cordial nature. I hope they will continue to be the same in the future. Believe me, my dear Sir Wilfrid, Very Sincerely yours, J. ISRAEL TARTE.
