The annual meeting of the New Dominion Dairying Co. was held in Afton Hall. The Secretary's report showed last season's work to be very satisfactory. The factory opened July first, closed Oct. 31st, during which time 281,376 lbs milk were received and 26066 lbs cheese manufactured. Gross value of cheese \$3075.78. Net value to patrons \$24,241.3. Average price of milk per 100lbs 86.44 cents. Foundry milk required to make 1lb cheese 10.81. Number patrons supplying milk 45. The Board of Directors for ensuing year consists of T. A. Stewart, Pres. Silas McNeill, Vice Pres; Hugh MacPhee, Jno. MacLean, Dan McPhee, A. A. McNeill and Hec. MacLean. Officers—A. A. MacNeill Salesman; Jno. MacLean Auditor, and Geo. Wilson, Secy. Treas.
