

HONOR AVIATOR PIONEERS TABLET IN MEMORY OF LANGLEY

Medals Awarded to Curtiss and Langley Aero-plane and Water-Flights Witnessed by President's Daughter.

ITALY WRONG IN SEIZING SHIPS

THE HAGUE, May 9 (Special).—The Franco-Italian Court of Arbitration, dealing with the seizure by Italian war ships during the Turco-Italian war of the French steamships Carthage and Manouba, decided that Italy was in the wrong and condemned the Italian government to pay \$32,000 and \$800 in the respective cases.

The Carthage was seized on January 16, 1912, on suspicion that she had contraband goods on board. She was released two days later on the request of the French government.

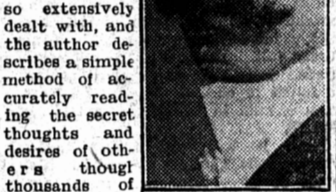
