TEMPERANCE MANIFESTO

To the Electors of Queen's County, P. E. I.
 In view of the fact that the Dominion Government have at the request of the requisite number of electors, granted an election on the 7th day of June next, to submit to you the repeal of the Canada Temperance Act, commonly known as the Scott Act, we desire to call to your attention the following reasons why you should on that date go to the polls and record your vote for the repeal of that Act, that the more efficient Provincial Prohibitory Law may come into force in your county.

1. Under the C. T. Act the penalties are \$50 for first offence, \$100 for second and two months imprisonment for third. Under local prohibition the penalties would be \$100 for first offence, \$200 for second and six months imprisonment for third. The local act is obviously more stringent and deterrent.

2. To obtain intoxicating liquor for medicinal purposes under the C. T. Act the certificate of a medical man is required. But such medical man may practice anywhere within the province or for that matter anywhere outside of it. The door is thus wide open for fraud. It is impossible to know or to prove that the certificates presented to the vendor are genuine. Under the Provincial Act the certificate must in all cases be from a resident physician.

3. Under the C. T. Act the liquor obtained under certificate at the vendor's shop must be removed from the premises; but there is no penalty for allowing its consumption there. Under the local act there is a fine of \$20 for permitting such liquor to be consumed on the premises.

4. Under the C. T. Act before a party convicted of a violation of the law can be arrested or imprisoned a warrant of distress must first issue to seize his goods. This means delay and frequently escape. Under the local act no warrant to distrain shall be issued.

5. The provisions of the local act respecting search of premises where intoxicating liquor is suspected to be kept for sale are more effective than under the C. T. Act. All liquor found is forfeited. The party in possession of it is fined and anyone interfering with the officer in his search is liable to a fine of \$100 or three months imprisonment.

6. By the amendment to the Prohibition Act, passed in 1905, any Stipendiary Magistrate for the City, Town or County, if satisfied on the oath of any police officer, policeman, constable, inspector or official prosecutor, that there is reasonable ground for belief that any liquor is sold or kept for sale contrary to the provisions of this act, in any place within his jurisdiction, may grant a warrant under his hand by virtue whereof it shall be lawful for the person or persons named in such warrant at any time or times within ten days from the date thereof, to enter if need be, by force, the place named in the warrant, and search for liquors therein. This clause, known as the "Right of Search," affords a most effective means of dealing with illicit liquor selling, and places the Local Act away in advance of the Scott Act.

7. Under the C. T. Act there is no standard by which to determine whether certain kinds of beer are intoxicating except by its effect on the party who consumed the liquor. Under the local prohibition act beer and other liquors are deemed intoxicating if they contain over three per cent of alcohol by volume.

8. The Local Government are responsible to the people for the enforcement of P. E. I. Prohibition Act, and being in touch with and responsible to the demands of the people, therefore the Act will be enforced, while the Scott Act depended upon voluntary workers and was very difficult of enforcement. In Charlottetown the Prohibition Act has been well enforced, and has proved great success in the decreasing of drunkenness. The Prohibition Act has entirely destroyed the political influences of the liquor sellers.

9. Now that Prince and King's Counties have adopted the Prohibition Act it only remains for Queen's County by unanimous vote to repeal the Scott Act in order that the whole province may have the benefit of the most advanced temperance legislation.

BIG FUSS ABOUT THOSE SEIZURES

WASHINGTON, May 16.—The seizure by Canadian cruisers of the fishing smacks Rayman of Boston, and Parthia of Gloucester adds another to the many vexatious cases of this kind regarding which the state department is now preparing to negotiate directly with the British government through Ambassador Durand upon his return to this country from England. It is pointed out, however, that from the press reports these new cases appear to differ essentially from those of the Gloucester boats seized a month ago off the Newfoundland coast and brought to St. John. While it is a debatable question as to whether the Newfoundland authorities were within their rights in arresting the Gloucester fishermen, who were there under the terms of the treaty of 1818, granting them equal privileges with British subjects in the shore waters, no such claim is made by the state department here as to the waters of New Brunswick or Nova Scotia and no American fisherman has the right to travel therein without the consent of the authorities.
