THE Cumberland Pork Packing Co. received one hundred hogs from Prince Edward Island one day last week. The company also purchased the first prize hogs at the Winter Fair, Amherst.

THERE is an epidemic of measles in a number of districts in Newfoundland which seems to be spreading to the Cape Breton towns. At present there are quite a number of cases of this disease in Sydney, North Sydney and the different mining towns.

It is stated that over a thousand men are employed in loading and unloading vessels at the winter port, St. John. The majority of these men belong to the city. Had they insisted upon keeping up the strike, this work would now be in the hands of Italians and other foreigners and the city men would probably be tramping the streets.

ALONG the line of the present agitation for the introduction of suitable immigrants into this Province the following is from the Colonial Herald of April 18th, 1841: "We congratulate the public on the advantages likely to be derived from the formation of a Society for the purpose of introducing into the Colony settlers of all descriptions, by means of which the wants of the Island will be made known and supplied. Many influential parties have already subscribed for the purpose, and we hope very shortly to be able to advertise the nature and particulars of the undertaking."

W. T. R. PRESTON, Canadian Immigration agent in London was in St. John the other day. He told the Board of Trade that immigrants should be induced to settle in that province. Mr. Preston outlined the practice in operation in Ontario, where some 20,000 immigrants settled during last year. The council of the board will endeavor to bring pressure to bear upon the provincial government to make additional efforts to secure for that province some of these immigrants. A similar action could be taken with good effect in Prince Edward Island.

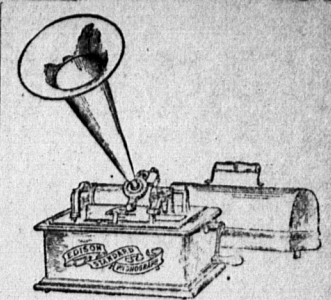
