From its situation a good view of the fertile farms of Knutsford and inviting looking farm-houses is obtained, with scenery combining the beautiful and half sublime. The improvements cost over \$300.00. This statement is to those who know how few in number the Baptists have been in this community, a strong faith and devotion that does great credit to those concerned. The building committee was composed of brethren Nelson Gay, H. S. Jelly, Isaac Harris. They gave plenty of time and labor to onerous yet grateful task of erecting a house for the Lord. The deacons of the church are H. S. Jelly and Wm. Gay. The church has a good leader in its pastor, brother C. S. Young, Lic. His pastorate extends over a number of stations, viz., Knutsford, Springfield, and Alma, and his labors would exhaust a man who did not combine physical strength with the wisdom that is profitable to direct, and the spiritual courage, faith and strength necessary to a good minister of Jesus Christ. Brother Young is doing a good work, and has done it well. He conducted the services of the dedication with distinct success. Good music was furnished by the choir under the leadership of Eva E., daughter of Brother Jas. P. Smallman. In the afternoon there was a public baptism when five happy believers followed their Saviors into the liquid tomb. The people for miles around gathered at the river's bank and listened in reverential spirit to the singing of the hymns, and the earnest words of the writer as he goes through the ceremonial. The people, the scenery, the life in man's forms and the memory of the hospitalities will linger long in the recollections of the writer. We congratulate the pastor, Brother Young, and the brethren at Knutsford on their advance movement, and can assure them of gratitude for their sacrifice on behalf of the best of causes.

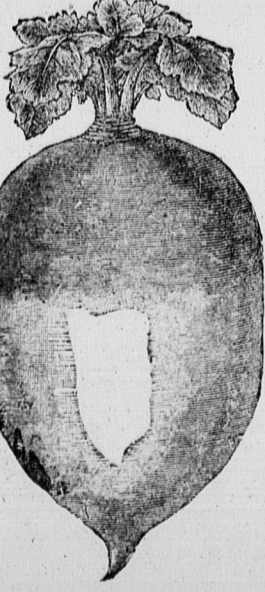
