

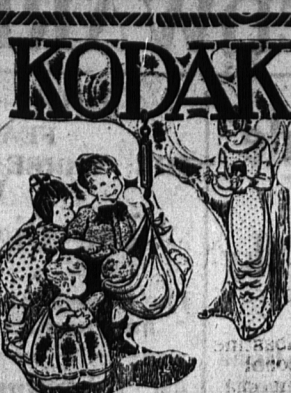

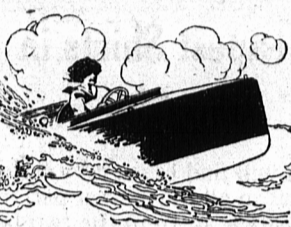

THE "PRINCE EDWARD."—The car ferry steamer did not reach Charlottetown yesterday until 2.10 p.m., being detained by fog, on account of which she was obliged to anchor in Caribou Channel for nearly three hours. She reports a large strip of ice off Wood Islands. The steamer had only two passengers, but brought some eighteen carloads of freight, including about 4 cars of flour, 1 car of machinery, 2 cars of cement, wire, and a car of cement. The two boilers of the steamer which have been out of action in order to be cleaned were filled last night and two others were emptied to undergo similar treatment.

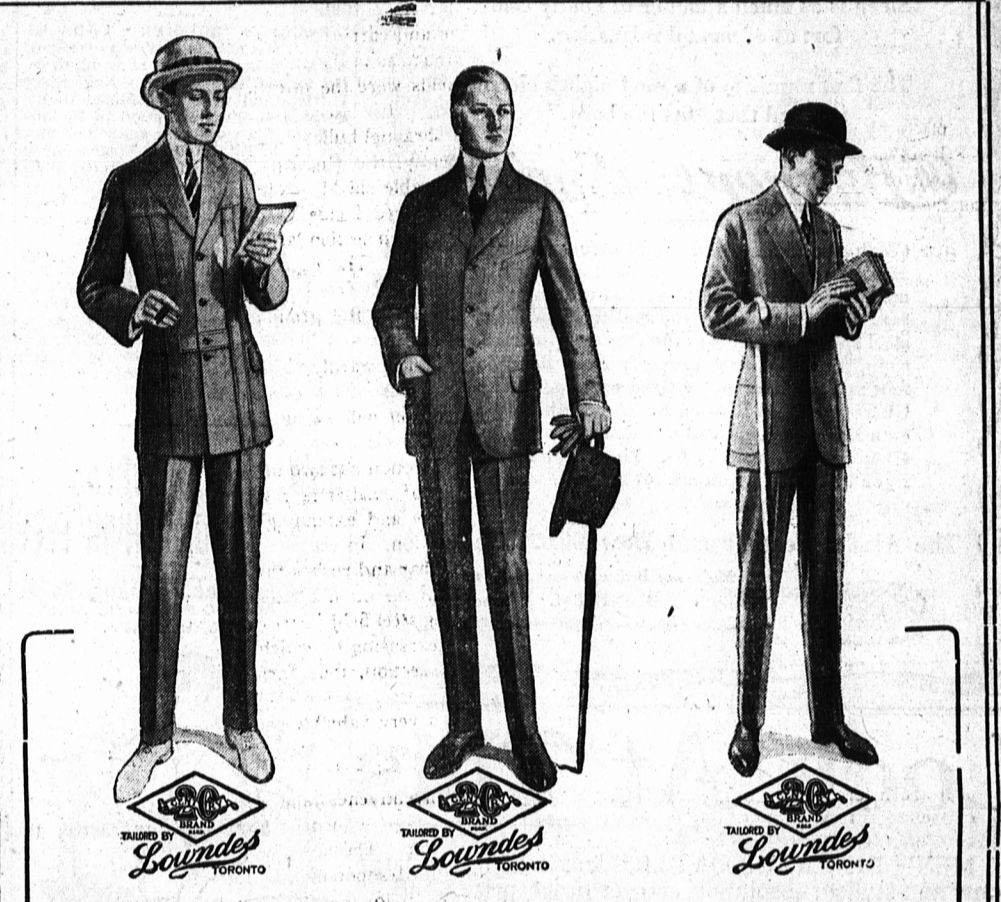
