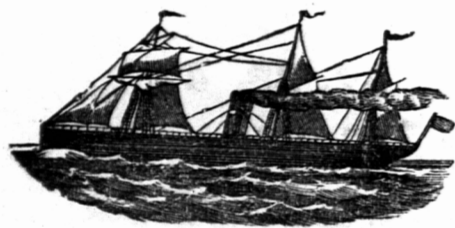

Presidents and College Educa-tions.

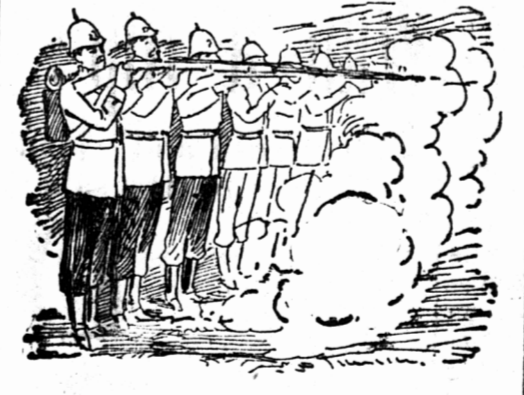
