When scouring the steel knives in use in every kitchen, if a little baking soda be mixed with the brick dust used, the spots will disappear with less rubbing, and the knives will stay bright much longer. Another thing of importance I have learned about scouring knives is the substitution of a cut raw potato for the cloth formerly used.

Another word for soda. Every house-keeper has experienced the annoyance of kerosene oil spilled on a clean kitchen floor, and knows the labor expended in eradicating the spot. If, before she attempts to scrub it off, she would sit over the spot baking soda, completely covering it, and allow the soda to remain for ten minutes or so, the grease will be drawn out, and when washed the spot will not be found.
