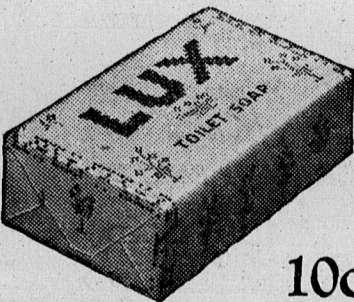

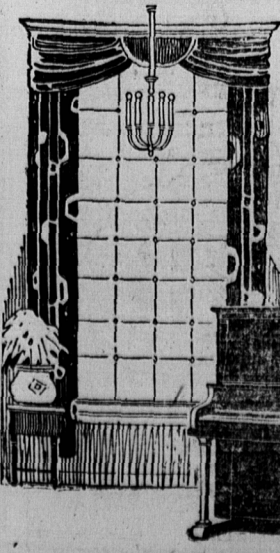

The Future Of Canada

SPEECH OF ALICE ELIZABETH MUSE. —MANITOBA—

It is with a feeling of overwhelming pride that I, a born Canadian, rise to give you my word picture of the glorious outlook of Canada's Future. My mind's eye is at once arrested by a clear vision of the unsullied greatness of her past history. Surely we have a right to be proud of the unique position Canada holds today in the very forefront of the civilized nations of the world. Nurtured in the lap of the Mother Country, fed and imbued with her life's blood and highest ideas, Canada's sons unfurled her banner of nationhood amid the suffocating gas at the second battle of Ypres April 23rd, 1915. Can you not hear the hoarse triumphant murmur of those gallant lads choking and dying by their scores on the historic fields of Flanders breathing the Empire's immortal motto: "What we have we'll hold." And these sons of the Bull Dog breed did hold on and did win that day, the verdict of the world's opinion henceforth is entitled to and qualified for, nationhood. Upon such a foundation it is a pleasure to build up block by block with the future manhood and womanhood of this beloved country of ours an edifice that will eventually stand four-square to the world as a structure upon which our children's children may gaze and feel truly proud.

There is no field of Canada's many activities so rich in possibilities as her untold mineral wealth. The Whitney Interests of New York are already in the field of our Province of Manitoba where they have begun to lay out the first million in a scheme of many millions of dollars, to wash gold, silver, and copper, from the hidden store house of the north, and as soon as their first success leaks out into the world what a constant flow of unlimited capital will be forthcoming to open out other dormant territories, where the richest mineral wealth of the world has been specially deposited. I am sure you will catch with me, the thrill of the blessings, that, that untold wealth wisely, and reverently used, will mean to Canada's future.

As a contributing power to home pleasure it is incomparable and as an adjunct to home environment it is invaluable. Nothing to my mind reveals the wonderful power of this twentieth century more than an article by Mrs. Philip Snowden. Listen to one of her paragraphs. "Never was there a discovery so fraught with possibilities for human happiness and well-being. Not since the world began has a power been revealed which the intellectual and spiritual life of whole nations was so brought under one control. Not one in a million understands its possibilities, not one in ten thousand appreciates its awful power."

GOVERNMENT

But through all these things I have mentioned will play no small part in Canada's Future, there are other matters which to my mind are of greater importance. Canada is justly proud to acknowledge that as a nation she is the offspring of our British Motherland whose name has always stood for all that is noblest and best in National ideals. Fortunate indeed are we to have the experience and example of the Motherland, from which to adapt our national institutions and ideals. We have profited and will continue to profit by that experience, we have followed and will continue to follow that example. Our system of Government is a direct descendant of that Mother of Parliaments—the nearest approach to a true democracy that man has yet devised. Canada will never give up that precious heritage but guided by the experience and perhaps the mistake of her own, the Motherland, and other nations she will press on until the goal of true democracy is reached. A government of the people, by the people, for the people. Where the will of the majority will be sustained, and the rights of the minority respected. Where complete freedom of thought, word, and action, will be allowed as long as they do not cause injury to others. Where our courts of law, unfettered and hampered will be true courts of justice preserving at all times the confidence of the people.

PRESS:

"The pen is mightier than the sword," and the Canadian press will wield a tremendous power in aiding or arresting the development of the future. May we trust that the fearless outspoken editorials of the past will be crowned with a same wide grasp of the potentialities of the Future and as propagandists of noble principles, with independence mingle tolerance, with courage, sympathy, and love, their weight of rhetoric and vision into guiding the people to a frame of mind pictured by MacAuley in the words which he placed in the mouth of the Old Roman minstrel:

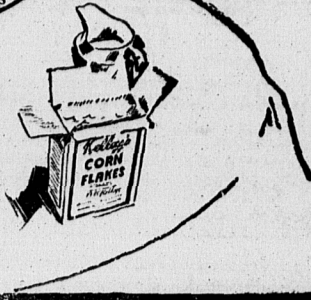
RELIGION:

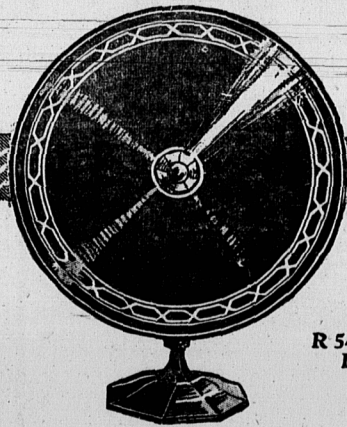
Modern Etiquette

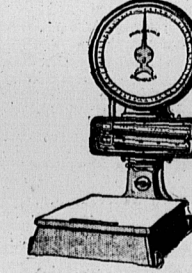
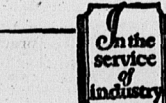
