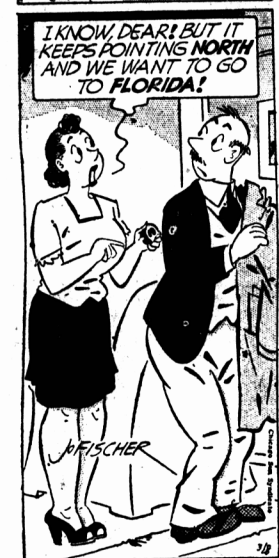

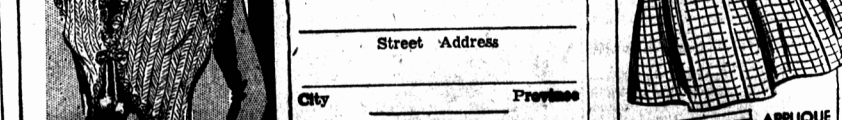
Q. When a husband and wife invite some friends for an auto ride, is it all right for those people to take their children along? A. That depends entirely upon how well trained the children are.
