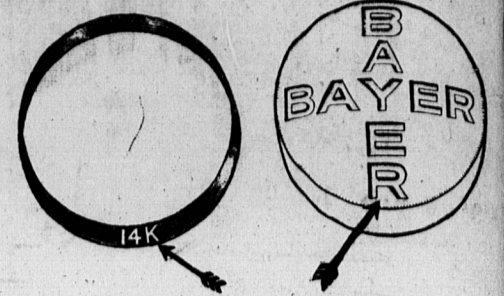
Happenings of the Week
