### CHURCHILL'S OPINION.

Before Returning to England Winston S. Churchill said:

"I ran across more Boer sympathizers in Chicago than elsewhere," said Mr. Churchill in an interview, "but they were not unreasonable after all.

"The Canadian people are more firmly in sympathy with Great Britain to-day, I think, than ever before, and the main reason for it is the part taken by Canadian troops in the South African war. Our brethren in Canada now feel that they are bone of our bone and flesh of our flesh. Winnipeg is destined to be the centre of gravity of British North America. I am of the opinion, after careful observation, that American women are the best educated of any in the world."

"Is the British Government likely to do anything for the widow of Major Seymour of Broome County in this state, the engineer who was killed while in charge of the railway pioneer squad that built bridges for the British army?" Mr. Churchill was asked.

"I remember the magnificent services rendered by Seymour," said Mr. Churchill "but I cannot tell what the Government is likely to do for his widow. As he was a citizen of the United States there might be some obstacle to any plan to reward his services by providing for his widow. Seymour's exceptional services may command unusual reward, however."
