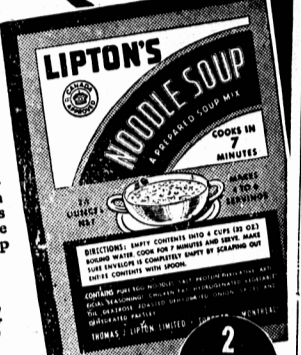

Price Control Questions And Answers

Questions and answers on Price Control will appear in The Guardian as a regular feature each day. The questions are those which have reached the Wartime Prices and Trade Board from housewives in this region. The answers are provided by the Board Readers. Persons who have intelligent questions to ask on price control are invited to send them in writing to the Women's Regional Advisory Committee of the War Time Prices and Trade Board.

Q I have asked my dressmaker to make me a cape for fall wear. She tells me this is a smart regulation. Is this correct?  
A Yes. Manufacturers are not allowed to make capes any more. These can be considered as luxury

garments and the regulation is designed to conserve material for more essential garments.  
Q I am a housewife and would like to help the war effort. I haven't much time to spare since we have two small children. Have you any suggestions?  
A Yes. Although you are busy with your children and your house you can still find time to help in the fight against inflation by joining the Consumer Branch of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board. If you get in touch with a liaison officer in your community, she will tell you how to keep track of prices when you do your shopping.  
Q How many coupons do I need to surrender for a 3 1/2 lb. bottle of corn syrup?  
A If the bottle contains less than 42 fluid ounces, three coupons only need be collected. Each coupon is worth 14 fluid ounces.

## Dorothy Dix Says—

### MODERATE TRAINING OF CHILD DIFFICULT FOR MOST PARENTS

### Some Mothers Dominate Lives Of Boys, Girls; Others Neglect Them; Fathers Guilty

One of the things that it seems most difficult for people to do is to achieve moderation in dealing with their children. They run to extremes. They are either too good parents, or no good at all. They love them to death, or are as indifferent to them as an alley cat is to its offspring. And which is the worst for the children, nobody knows. Of course, both fathers and mothers are guilty of overdoing this parent business, but it is the mothers who are the chief offenders, because they have more time to give to it and hence can turn out a more perfect job. All of us know women whose children never draw one free breath from the time they are born until Mother is laid in her coffin. Mother dominates every phase of their existence.

### SOME MOTHERS DOMINATE CHILDREN

Mother's ever watchful eye is upon them and she keeps tab on their outgoings and incomings. She forms their tastes and habits. Picks out their clothes for them. Selects their friends. She always holds them by the hand and never lets them learn to stand on their own feet. She never reads anything but baby books. Her whole conversation is a monologue about Janie and Susan and Tom and Dick. Ever her husband doesn't exist for her except as the man who works to provide the children with clothes and food and sports cars and coming out parties.

Worse still, she wrecks her children for time and eternity by spoiling them to death. She never corrects their faults or their manners. She never denies them anything that is possible to obtain by hook or by crook. She never teaches them to control their temper, or that they have any duties and responsibilities in life. She makes herself a dogmat for them to kick around. She turns their human material into hoodlums and wastrels, and is first aid to the divorce court and the penitentiary.

### OTHER MOTHERS NEGLECT THEIR OFFSPRING

On the other hand, there is the woman who bears children but refuses to mother them. She never lets them cradle her style, or kiss her away from another party after she leaves the maternity hospital. If she is rich, she turns her children over to nurses and governess and camps and schools to rear. If she is poor, she shoves them on the street where they cut their milk teeth on the hard and bitter wisdom of the gutter.

She is too busy with her clubs her career, her job, her convicts and goings and pleasures and amusements to bother with a bunch of kids, so she lets them tumble up the best way they can, without ever knowing what it really is to have a mother, or a home. And that so many of these children, who have never known any restraint, who have never been taught any high ideals or had a mother's guidance, develop into decent men and women proves that the days of miracles are not over. When women are so much mothers that they are hardly human, as Bernard Shaw said in one of his plays, they are bad enough. Heaven knows, but when men have the father complex, they are worse. They let them do any of the things that the boys and girls of their age do. And the result is that if they are good obedient daughters, he turns them into old maids and if they have any snark, they climb out of the window and close with some rounder they picked up at the corner drug store.

It is pitiful to think how often parents wreck the lives of their children and break their own hearts by not treating their youngsters with moderation.

### FATHERS FORGET CHANGES IN LIFE

They forget that the whole world has changed since they were boys and that the emancipation of youth is just as much a fact as the Revolutionary War, and that because Father has spent his life building up a grocery trade for John to go into is no fact that John is going to have a heart interest in soups or thrill over selling cheese and butter.

And worst of all, Father believes that the way to protect the daughters he adores is to virtually lock them up in a prison cell and deprive them of all the pleasures that belong to their time of life. ## THE COOK'S CORNER

### ITALIAN PRUNE JAM

4 pounds prune plums  
3 pounds sugar

Method: Wash the prunes and stem them, then cut in halves and remove the stones. Mix the prepared fruit and sugar together and heat slowly stirring constantly to dissolve the sugar. When this is dissolved, cook more quickly until the mixture thickens, or until the juice will test for jelly. Remove from the fire, skim, if necessary and seal in hot, sterilized jars.

### PRUNE PLUM CONSERVE

3 pounds prune plums  
3 oranges  
4 1-2 cups sugar

Method: Pick over the prune plums, wash, stem and then cut them in halves and stone them. Weigh the prepared fruit and then add to it the orange juice, the grated rind, and the sugar. Heat the mixture slowly, stirring until all the sugar is dissolved, then bring to a boil and boil as rapidly as possible until the mixture is thick and clear. Pour into hot sterilized jars and seal with melted paraffin. Store covered jars in a cool, dry place.

### REMOVING SPOTS

Here are some rules on removing spots from clothes so as to lengthen their life:

Spots caused by chemicals should be treated before the garment is submerged in soap and water. When using a solvent, it's advisable to work from the outer edge toward the centre. Hems make good "guinea pigs" — try solvent on their undersides before applying it to the soiled surfaces.

Renew your sponge pads frequently, and be sure to work in a strong, clear light. To simplify the removal of spots, it is suggested that a cupboard be equipped with small china bowls, bone spoons, crochet hooks or knitting needles, a small glass rod, one or two clean pads of material, a fountain pen filler, blotting paper and some of the stamper agents for removing spots.

### TASTIER FISH DISHES

If the broiled fish still seems dry and flavorless after careful cooking, serve tartare sauce or mayonnaise with it. A spreading of either dressing will add moisture and interest at once.
