RUSSIAN PRESS IS PESSIMISTIC

Wild Scenes on Thursday in the Russian Parliament—Cries of "Murder", "Dog" and "Assassin" hurled at the Military Procurator.

St. PETERSBURG, June 15.—The press is unanimous in its profound pessimism over yesterday's events in the Lower House of Parliament, when the house was rocked and swayed by scenes of violence provoked by a series of government communications. Procurator Pavloff, after reading his communication in a hurried, agitated voice, immediately left the hall, but not too soon to escape cries of "murderer", "assassin" and "dog" from the Radicals who had ported themselves in all parts of the hall.

So fierce was the storm that President Mouroussoff was compelled to announce that he would be compelled to adjourn the session if the demonstration was continued. The situation is strained to the breaking point. The attempt of Military Procurator General Pavloff in behalf of War Minister Rudjick to shift the responsibility of the executions to the Minister of the Interior is a palpable evasion of the issue raised by the house and has reached throughout the country, with the result that a storm of indignation has been aroused and is being augmented by the cool attempt of the government to invade the inviolability of members of Parliament and its demand for the expulsion of M. Ulanoff. Whether the government dares legally to follow up the refusal of the house to expel M. Ulanoff and its flogging of Procurator Pavloff is now the question.

Unless the Government is definitely resolved to give battle the Goermykin ministry must fall into the chasm between it and Parliament, which is unbridgeable. M. Alldin, leader of the peasant workman group, openly boasted from the rostrum yesterday that the death of the ministers would be the country's rejoinder to the government's refusal to abolish the death penalty.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 32, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less. Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated. Entries must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated. The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years. (2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased, of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother. (3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land. Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands as follows: (1) In writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, or (2) In writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated.
