 salt from Cadiz, Spain for DeBlais

 Banks and lost some sail, which
 will be secured here before leav-
 ing. At the time of leaving
 Spain, August 19th, Captain Pye
 heard no rumors of the revolution-
 ary disturbance which has since
 taken place in that country. The

 from St. John to England with lum-
 ber. Capt. Pye visited here in
