Chases 3000 Mile Bride Over a State

Miner's Successful Hunt for Girl Who Crosses Continent, But Misses Him - Belated Telegram - Age of Chivalry Is Not Dead.

CHESTER, Pa., June 7.—Word has been received in this city announcing the marriage of Miss Anna W. Abrams, of Chester, and Fred M. Mynton, a graduate of the Pennsylvania Military College, now superintendent of Cranberry Mining Company, of Cranberry, Cal. The wedding took place in Los Angeles, but the pair experienced a number of provoking incidents before the nuptial knot was finally tied.

On Wednesday evening, May 16, when Miss Abrams left on her 3000-mile trip from this city to San Bernardino, it was with the expectation that she would meet the man who would make her his bride. Business compelled Mynton to alter his plans, so he wired his fiancée to delay the trip a few days.

The telegram did not reach its destination until after the young woman had started West, however, Mynton receiving a letter which reached him at the mining camp about the same time his bride was due to arrive at San Bernardino. Not waiting to change his business suit of Khaki, the young man jumped into his automobile and was soon heading for the station where his fiancée was awaiting him, as he thought.

Not finding Mr. Mynton at the depot, according to promise, Miss Abrams took the next train for Los Angeles, to which city she was followed by Mynton. After hunting through the register of one hotel after another, the young man was advised to go to the railroad station and look for Miss Abrams' baggage. Here he found her trunk, and waited several hours beside the precious bit of evidence until it was called for by a messenger, whom he followed to the hotel, where he found his bride.

LEMIEUX ACT SCORES AGAIN.

OTTAWA, June 5.—The price of bread in Ottawa has been advanced from ten to eleven cents a loaf. The bakers give the increase in the price of flour as the reason.

The Lemieux labor act has scored another bloodless triumph. The ministers of labor have received a telegram from President Sherman, head of the Western Miners' organization, stating "Satisfactory agreement signed today with the Alberta Railway and Engineering Company. No need of board conciliation now, thanks to industrial disputes act. Congratulations."

In this case a strike would have occurred at Lethbridge if it had not been for the men and the owners of the mine to come to terms. The men had voted to strike and the mine owners had shown a disposition to meet them and discuss terms. President Nanton, of the company, protested against a board of conciliation being forced upon him. Mr. Lemieux firmly informed him that if there was a dispute it would have to be investigated and stated that he was going to constitute a board. Seeing that there was nothing to be done for it Mr. Nanton surrendered gracefully, and the telegram from Mr. Sherman announces that the parties have anticipated the organization of the board of investigation by settling the dispute and leaving nothing to be investigated.

MRS. GOULD S HUSBAND BAD

She Makes Serious Charges Against Him in Separation Suit.

New York, June 6.—T of Mr. Howard Gould, who has a separation from her husband, Gould, who was given public airing in court today. The occasion was the hearing of arguments on motion of counsel for Mr. Gould to strike out certain allegations in Mrs. Gould's complaint. Arguments of considerable length were made both for and against the motion, and at their conclusion the attorneys were given until Monday to file briefs in the case. The grounds on which Mr. Gould is suing her husband as shown by parts of the complaint read by counsel for Mr. Gould, are:

First, abandonment of Mr. Gould by her husband; second, the allegation that the habits and conduct of Mr. Gould are such that it was improper for his wife to live with him; third, that since September last, he has neglected his wife and refused to provide her, except that he paid for her support at a New York hotel since that time, and fourth, that Gould had treated her with extreme cruelty, employed spies to harass her, caused her mailbag to be tampered with, maintained illicit relations with women of bad character, and that he employed an ex-convict and several New York detectives to secure improper evidence against Mrs. Gould.

DeLaney Nicoll, who argued the case for Mr. Gould, said that every allegation against Mr. Gould will be denied when he answers to the suit is filed.
