Pétain Saved French Army

Gen. Petain's first problem on taking command of the French army was to improve its morale. This he accomplished by carefully considering the soldiers' complaints, doing everything possible to increase their comfort and later by carrying out a series of limited offensive operations.

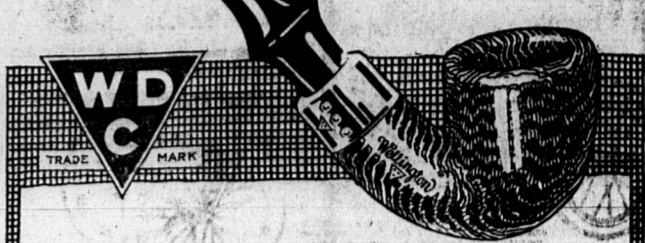
