PREPARING FOR DEATH AND BIRTH

KINGSTON, June 29—It is understood that Dr. Daniel Phelan, surgeon of the provincial penitentiary and recognized as the government expert criminologist, has gone to Saint Ste. Marie, at the request of the minister of justice, to report upon Mrs. Angelina Napolitana, the young Italian woman under sentence of death for the murder of her husband, Mrs. Napolitana will hang on August 30th, unless the department intervenes. Why the unfortunate woman is preparing for her own death and for her baby's birth, women throughout the United States and Canada are weaving an endless chain of prayers and petitions for her freedom. The King of England, the King of Italy, the governor general of Canada and Canada's minister of justice will receive the plea of women whose sympathy has been touched by the tragedy of this unhappy Italian woman.

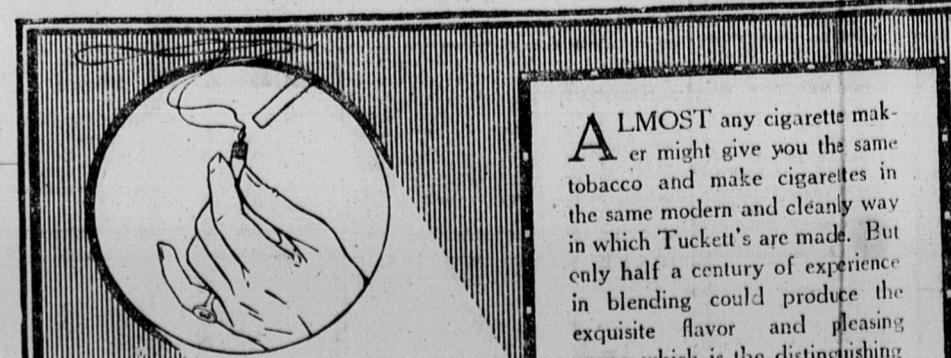
