A VERY successful Sunday School Convention was held in the Baptist Church at Murray River on Thursday Feb. 26th. Mr. E G Geddings the president of South Kings District presided. The day was fine and large audiences assembled and were prided by the addresses and discourses. The report from schools showed that of the thirteen schools in the District eleven kept open all the year. This is the banner District for evergreen schools. Gladstone Union; and Murray Harbor South, president reports Home Departments. Murray Harbor South Methodist reports a weekly teachers meeting and new maps and black boards. A new school has recently been organized in Toronto, with Mr. E G Geddings as Superintendent. The resident pastors were added to the executive. Miss A E Horton read an excellent paper on 'Prayer as an aid in S S work.' Mr. E G Geddings spoke on 'Love as a foundation in S S work.' Rev E Gillis spoke on 'Necessity of Bible study by the S S teacher.' Rev A D McCully led the devotional service at the evening session. 'The Holy City' was sung by Miss Roberts of Murray Harbor South. The Field Secretary conducted helpful conferences and complimented the District officers on the painstaking interest manifested by this successful Convention in which nearly every school is represented. A resolution expressing regret that Rev H Carter pastor of the Murray River Baptist Church was soon leaving the Province and expressing appreciation of his Christian fellowship, was moved by Rev E Gillis and seconded by Rev A D McCully and passed unanimously. Mr. John McDonald of Caledonia was present at the evening session and gave an address. The next Convention will meet at Glen Williams on the second Thursday of August.
