BRITAIN'S WOODEN WALLS.

LONDON, March 16.—The secretary of the admiralty incidentally mentioned that 21 obsolete vessels had been withdrawn during the year 1902-03, the largest number on record, and said that on April 1, 1903, there would be under construction the enormous total of 71 ships namely, 11 battleships, 19 armoured cruisers, 2 second class cruisers, 4 third class cruisers, 4 scouts, 2 sloops, 18 torpedo boat destroyers, 8 torpedo boats and 3 submarine boats.

POSTAL CLERKS CONSULT.

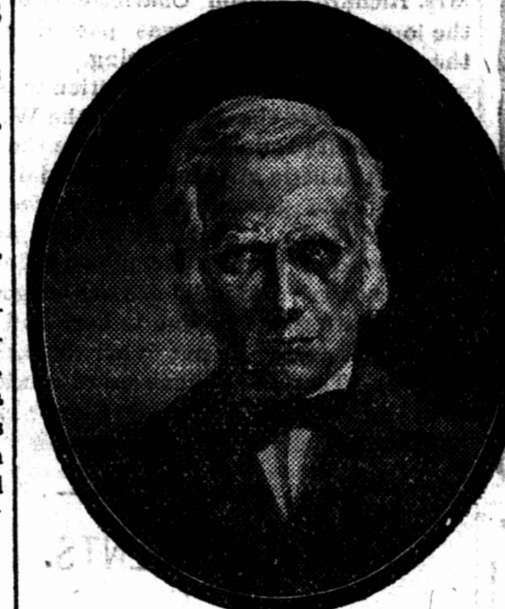

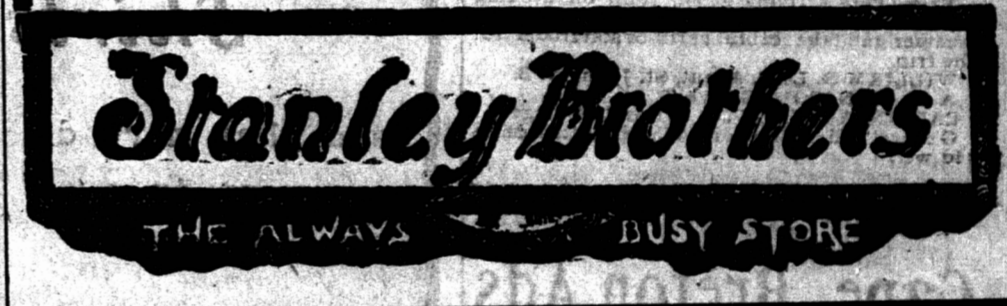
