MR. BORDEN'S LEADERSHIP.

The question of Mr. Borden's leadership of the Conservative Opposition has been somewhat discussed in the ministerial press of late.

The Liberal party in its time of opposition had also its troubles over the party leadership. First it tried Mr. Macenzie, then Mr. Blake and finally Mr. Laurier.

Mr. Borden was chosen leader of the Opposition in 1901, and in the following election of 1904 the Government's majority was largely increased.

Mr. Borden has today no real rival for the leadership in his own party. A possible choice would be Sir Pliny Whitney.

Aside from Sir Pliny Whitney there is no other man in or out of federal public life who could have any chance of becoming the choice of the Conservative party as against Mr. Borden.

The circumstances are few under which a newspaper might not properly publish a letter from a Presbyterian minister over his own signature.
