



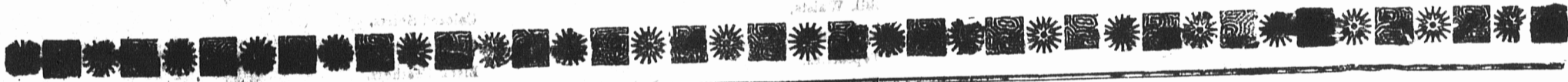

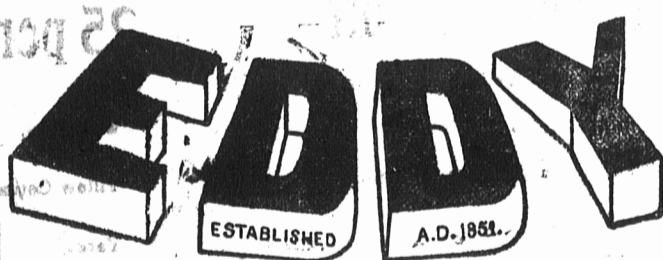

To Fight Storm and Frost.
An earnest effort is to be made in France to fight nature with her own weapons in the realm of the storms and frosts. A company has issued a prospectus asking for \$600,000 capital in order, first, to send from and to various centers by wireless telegraphy a complete description of any storm that arises and of the course it is pursuing; second, to have apparatus ready for dissipating hailstorms by firing explosives into the air; third, by the automatic lifting of numerous piles of combustible materials over a large area to produce artificial clouds which will serve as a protection against the attacks of frost.

Bedroom Screen as a Present.
A pretty and inexpensive screen for a bedroom is an excellent Christmas gift. It may be made with the aid of several yards of cream colored Brussels net. The net is first gathered, top and bottom, on a stout linen thread and then stretched tightly on the screen by means of tiny brass headed tacks. It may be necessary to cover the screen with cheap silk or white or some other shade in order to prevent the original covering from showing through the net. The frame might also be finished in cream color.
