The females are a first-class lot in every respect and in good condition though just off the grass. They are intended for breeding purposes, and will be a valuable addition to this breed of cattle now so popular on our western ranches. It is worthy of note that some of the cattle sent out by Mr. Richards last year were prominent prize-winners at the big International Fair at Winnipeg held this autumn.

FACING STARVATION. LONDON, October 10. At a meeting of the Manchester city council it was announced that, owing to the hard times, and depression in the cotton industries, between 40,000 and 50,000 people in the poorer parts of the city were practically on the verge of starvation. Similar conditions prevail in London and other large cities of the United Kingdom, where the winter is expected to be one of the hardest in many years for the poorer classes.

EAST GLASTONBURY, Conn., October 10. - John Whipple, the farmer who for two weeks had defied capture by the state police, was hanged in and caught in a barn at South Glastonbury at five o'clock yesterday afternoon. 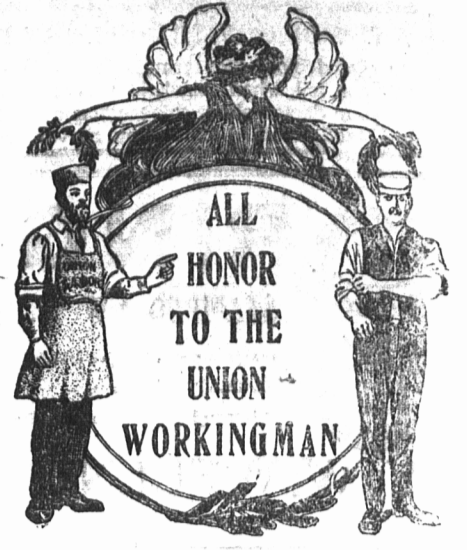
