INC REASED PROSPERITY OF THE IRISH PEOPLE DUBLIN, June 10—Every now and again some little evidence crops up showing the increased prosperity of Ireland, and proving that this prosperity is due not to outside assistance, but to the fact that Irishmen and Irishwomen have learned they must help themselves if they expect to accomplish anything.

There are no comparative figures for England, but there are other methods of comparison which show that the Irishman as a practical farmer is far ahead of his slower going English cousin, and that he is coming up to the standard of his keen Danish competitor. For instance, it was learned at this conference that Ireland exports every year over \$18,000,000 worth of poultry produce, while England, which has neglected the hen as a source of wealth, imports annually \$35,000,000 of eggs alone, and at least \$50,000,000 of poultry produce of all kinds.

All this is due largely to the work of one man, Sir Horace Plunkett, at whose house in Dublin, presented to him by a grateful nation, the poultry conference was held. When he was head of the department of agriculture he worked unceasingly to encourage the establishment of co-operative buying and selling organizations for farmers. Today the country is linked up by thousands of co-operative creameries and butter and bacon factories, and egg depots.

If this goes on, Ireland in a few years will be another Denmark, and the credit for it will be due to Irishmen.
